Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD), Regional Meteorological Centre (RMC), Peshawar invites pre-qualified firms as mentioned on the website (www.pc.gov.pk) of Ministry of Planning Development and Special Initiative (PD&SI) for the **Evaluation/Feasibility** of the Naran site the PSDP Project entitled "Construction of meteorological observatory at Naran and bachelor hostel for operational staff at Balakot".

PROCEDURE AND MECHANISM FOR APPLY

1. Interested firms are requested to submit their bids (Technical & Financial) through E-PAD on single stage - two envelope basis on or before **02nd June, 2026 by 1100 hours** which will be opened on the same **date at 1130 hours** in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives (if any) in the office of Director, Regional Meteorological Centre, Peshawar.
2. Bids should be accompanied by bid security (2% of the bid cost refundable) in the form CDR in favor of the Director RMC, Peshawar. Scanned copy should be submitted along with Technical bid on EPAD. However, the original bid security shall be submitted on or before the deadline to the address given below.
3. The detailed eligibility criteria and procurement procedure is attached.
4. In case of any unforeseen situation resulting in closure of office on the date of opening of tender or if the Govt. announced holiday, the bid will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
5. No query will be entertained at the time of bid opening date & time. All government taxes should be included in the bid cost.
6. Incomplete/disfiguring/overwriting/conditional will be considered non-responsive. The Director RMC has the right to reject one or all proposals prior to acceptance in accordance with PPRA rules.
7. Payment will be made after successful completion of task, through AGPR, Peshawar.

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Scope of Work (SOW):

Feasibility Study, Hazard Assessment and Safety Evaluation for Proposed PMD Office & Residential Buildings at Naran

Background

Pakistan Meteorological Department owns approximately 11 kanals of land at Naran in two separate pieces measuring approximately 07 kanals and 04 kanals respectively. The Department intends to construct office buildings, staff residential accommodations, and associated infrastructure on the said land. The area has reportedly been in front of Glacier. Therefore, PMD requires a detailed third-party feasibility study and hazard/safety assessment prior to initiation of any civil works.

The consultancy shall evaluate the suitability, safety, environmental vulnerability, and engineering feasibility of the sites and recommend mitigation measures and safe construction parameters.

The consultant shall:

1. Collect topographic, geological, hydrological, meteorological, glaciological, land-use data and Review historical records and compile a comprehensive report and submit to this office within 15 days after awarding the tender.
2. Assess the overall suitability and safety of both land pieces for proposed construction.
3. Evaluate glacier-related hazards, hydrological risks, geotechnical stability, and climate-related threats.
4. Recommend engineering and structural safety measures.
5. Suggest resilient infrastructure standards suitable for high mountain environments.
6. The consultant shall Conduct detailed site visits and inspection surveys.
7. Submit the detailed BOQs of the approved design/proposal(s) & provide detailed drawings of the proposal

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Bidding Procedure:**
 - Single Stage-one Envelope Procedure as per PPRA Rule 36 (a).
2. **Eligibility Criteria:**

Bidders must:

 - Be Registered with FBR (Valid NTN & GST)
 - Provide an affidavit of non-blacklisting
 - Show proof of similar supplier to the government / semi-government entities
 - Pre-qualified firms as mentioned on the website (www.pc.gov.pk) of Ministry of Planning Development and Special Initiative (PD&SI)
3. **Bid Submission:**
 - Submit bids through PPRA EPADS and to the Office of the **Director, Regional Meteorological Center (RMC)** Khyber Road Peshawar.
4. **Bid Security (Earnest Money):**
 - 2% bid security of the total quoted amount (inclusive of GST) must be submitted as a Pay order/ Bank draft in favor of Director, RMC Peshawar in Pakistani Currency.
 - Bid without Earnest Money will be rejected.
5. **Bid Validity:**
 - The bids shall remain valid for a period of three months (90 days) from the date of opening of the tender (Rule 28)
 - If required, the procuring agency may request an extension in the validity period, subject to the written consent of the bidder.
6. **Supply Schedule:**
 - The successful bidder shall deliver the items on quarterly basis as per the procuring agency requirements (Rule 15)
 - Quantities and delivery schedules will be communicated prior to start of each quarter.
 - The bidder must ensure timely delivery to avoid disruption in operations.
7. **Delivery Schedule:**
 - Items must be delivered within 15 days of issuance of the purchase order.
 - A 1% penalty per day will apply for delays beyond the specific time.
8. **Payment Terms:**
 - Payment will be made via Cheque through AGPR after the satisfactory delivery by the Technical Committee.
9. **Taxes:**
 - Prices quoted must be inclusive of all applicable taxes.
 - Taxes will be deducted at source as per governments rule.
10. **Rejection of Bids:**
 - The procuring agency reserves the right to reject any or all bid as per PPRA Rule 33.
11. **Bid Opening:**
 - Bid will be publicly opened online through PPRA EPADS at the specified date and time in presence of bidders or their representatives.
