

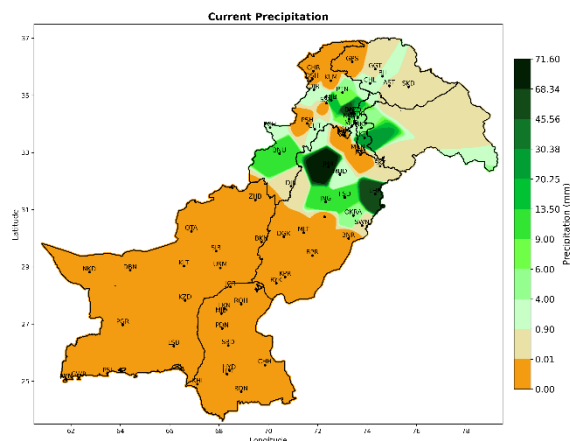
Weekly Weather and Crop Bulletin for Pakistan

Week (08th – 14th June 2026)



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Highlights of Past Weather (08th – 14th June 2026)

- Light to moderate rainfall was observed over scattered places of central Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Whereas dry weather was reported from southern Punjab, Sindh and Balochistan.
- Day time maximum temperatures remained above normal in most parts of the country except Punjab where normal to slightly below normal temperatures were recorded.
- Daily minimum and mean temperatures were reported above normal over most parts of the country except upper Punjab where near normal temperatures were observed.

Punjab

Light to moderate rainfall was observed from the scattered places of central Punjab while hot and dry weather was reported from rest of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 40.4°C & 26.1°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 154.3 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 45% and wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 3.0/3.2 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 71.60 mm at Joharabad during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 48.0°C at Bhakkar.

Crops: Peanut (Pothohar Region), Maize (Northeastern Punjab), Cotton (Central and Southern Punjab)

Balochistan

Mainly dry weather prevailed over the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 39.4°C & 25.4°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 191.7 growing degree days were accumulated. The average relative humidity recorded was 30% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening was recorded 1.9/6.1 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 50.5°C at Sibbi

Crops: Wheat

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Light to moderate rainfall was reported from the scattered places of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 35.7°C & 20.7°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 127.2 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 47% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 1.1/10.4 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 58.00 mm from Balakot during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as

45.0°C at Bannu.

Crops: Maize

Sindh

Dry weather was reported from the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 43.3°C & 28.8°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 168.6 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 52%, and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 5.0/5.2 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 51.0°C at Dadu and Nawabshah.

Crops: Cotton

Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir

Light rainfall was reported from Gilgit Baltistan and light to moderate rainfall was reported from Azad Jammu & Kashmir during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 32.6°C & 17.1°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 139.5 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 40%, and mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.3/2.8 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 27.00 mm from Kotli during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.0°C at Muzaffarabad.

Crops: Wheat

Past Weather for Major Agricultural Plains
(08th – 14th June 2026)

Rawalpindi (Pothohar region)

Dry weather was reported from Rawalpindi during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 1.9/1.7 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity was observed as 42%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.7°C & for the recent week, 181.9 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/0.3 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.0°C.

**Past Weather for Sub-Regional Agricultural
Plains (08th – 14th June 2026)**

Multan

Dry weather was reported from Multan during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 0.7/1.0 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity observed as 40%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 40.8°C & for the recent week, 1 60.7 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 5.1/5.4 Knots.

Lahore

Rainfall was reported as 51.00 mm from Lahore during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 1.3/1.4 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 43%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.7°C & for the recent week, 162.1 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.3/3.1Knots.

Zhob

Dry weather was reported from Zhob during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 0.3/1.4 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 25%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.5°C & for the recent week, 181.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.4/4.6Knots.

Murree

Rainfall was reported as 3.01 mm from Murree during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.0/2.4 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity observed as 53%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 26.5°C & for the recent week, 73.1 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.7/1.1 Knots.

D.I. Khan

Rainfall was reported as 0.01 mm (Trace) from D.I Khan during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 0.0/1.1 Oktas. Average relative humidity was observed as 49%. Mean day time

Rainfall was reported as 12.60 mm from Faisalabad during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 1.0/0.2 Oktas during the week, average relative humidity was observed as 47%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 40.1°C & for the recent week, 198.2 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.8/2.3 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.5°C.

Tandojam (Lower Sindh)

Dry weather was reported from Tandojam during the week, however, sky remained clear during the week while average relative humidity recorded as 65%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 40.5°C & for the recent week, 196.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 5.4/4.6 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 42.0°C.

Usta Muhammad (Eastern Baluchistan)

Dry weather was reported from Usta Muhammad during the week, sky remained clear during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 40%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 47.8°C & for the recent week, 231.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.5/3.1 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 51.0°C.

Quetta (Northern Baluchistan)

Dry weather was reported from Quetta during the week, sky remained clear during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 16%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 34.1°C & for the recent week, 152.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 4.5/2.2 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 36.5°C.

temperature was recorded as 41.3°C & for the recent week, 168.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.3/2.3 Knots.

Peshawar

Dry weather was reported from Peshawar during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 0.3/2.1 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 40%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 41.0°C & for the recent week, 157.6 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.4/3.4 Knots.

Kalam

Dry weather was reported from Kalam during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.7/2.7 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 37%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 26.7°C & for the recent week, 65.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop.

Gilgit

Rainfall was reported as 0.02 mm from Gilgit during the week; cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.6/4.9 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 35%. Mean day time temperature recorded as 34.0°C & for the recent week, 139.6 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/3.1 Knots.

Skardu

Rainfall was reported as 0.50 mm from Skardu during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.7/4.6 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 37%. The mean day time temperature recorded as 28.3°C & for the recent week, 105.9 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 00/4.0 Knots.

Pothohar Region (Rawalpindi)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Rawalpindi.

Central Punjab (Faisalabad)

Condition: *Good*.

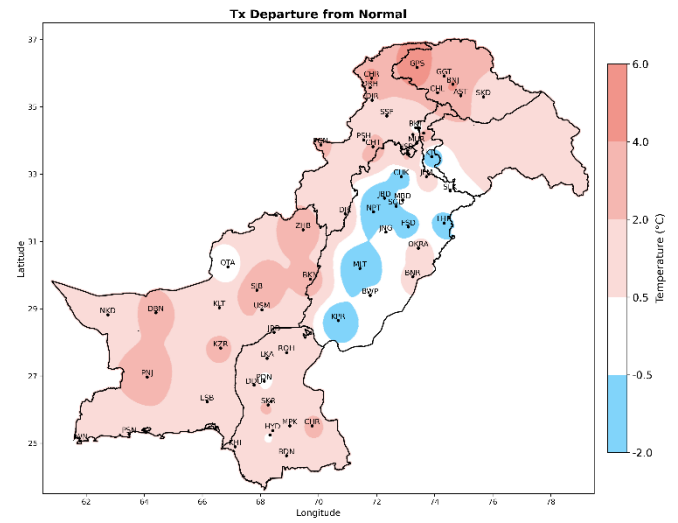
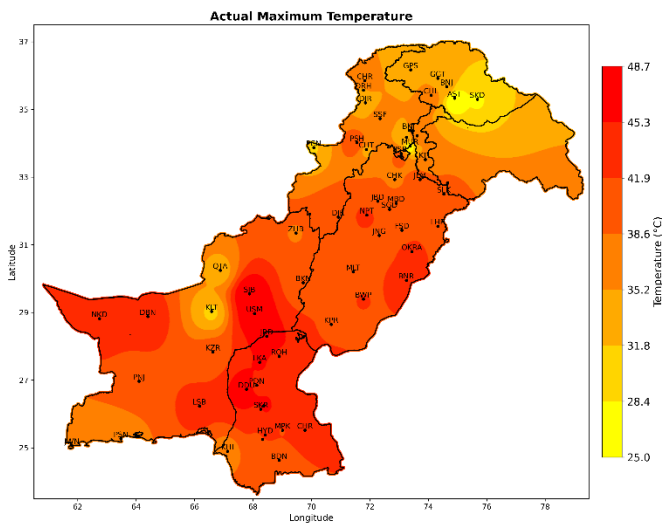
Northern Baluchistan (Quetta)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Quetta.

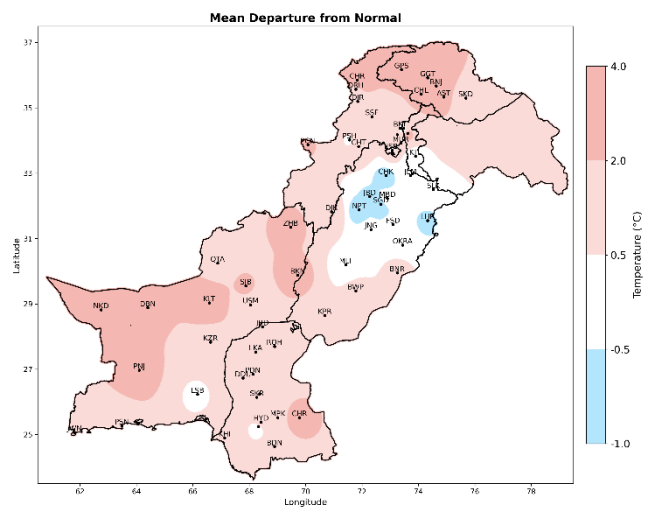
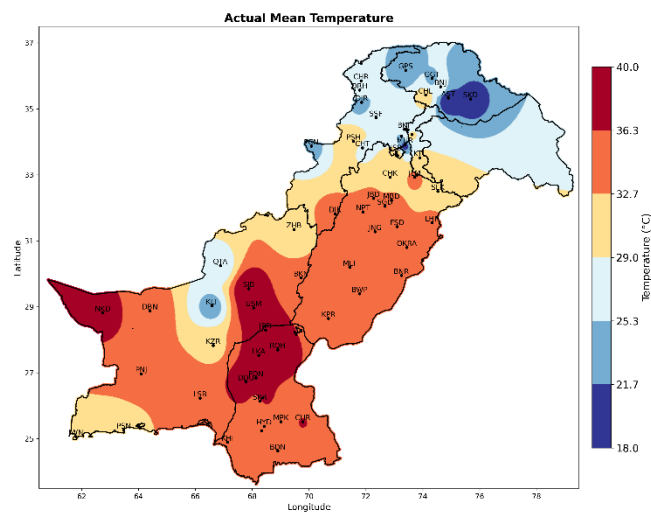
Eastern Baluchistan (Usta Muhammad)

Field is being prepared for rice pinery.

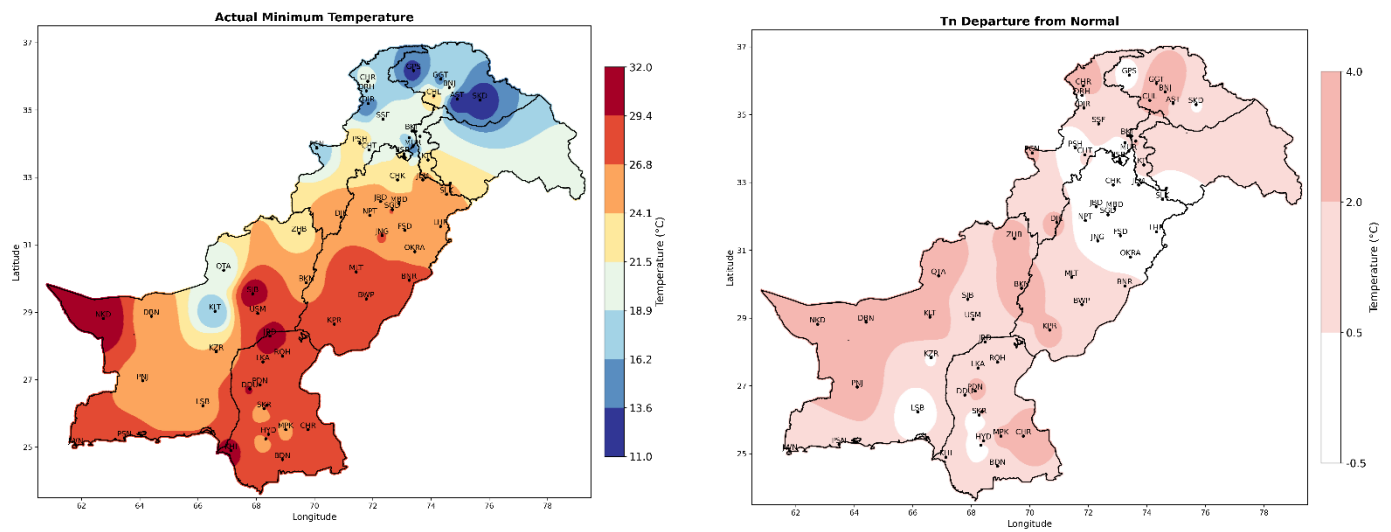
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (08th – 14th June 2026)



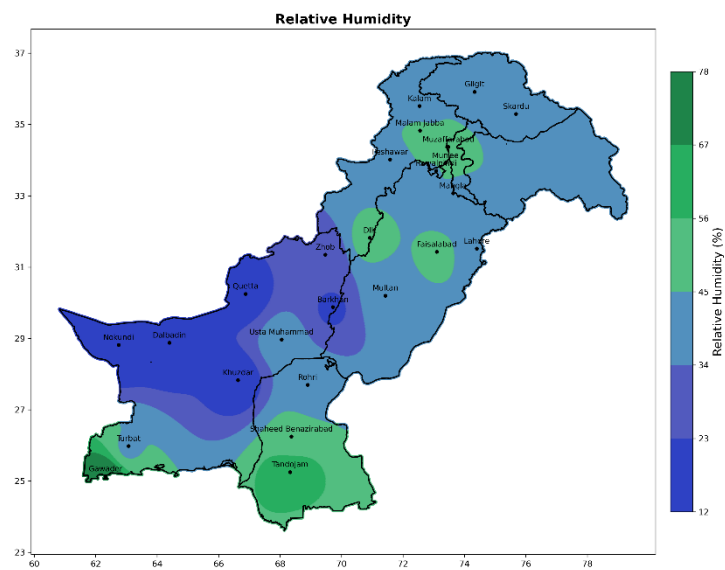
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (08th – 14th June 2026)



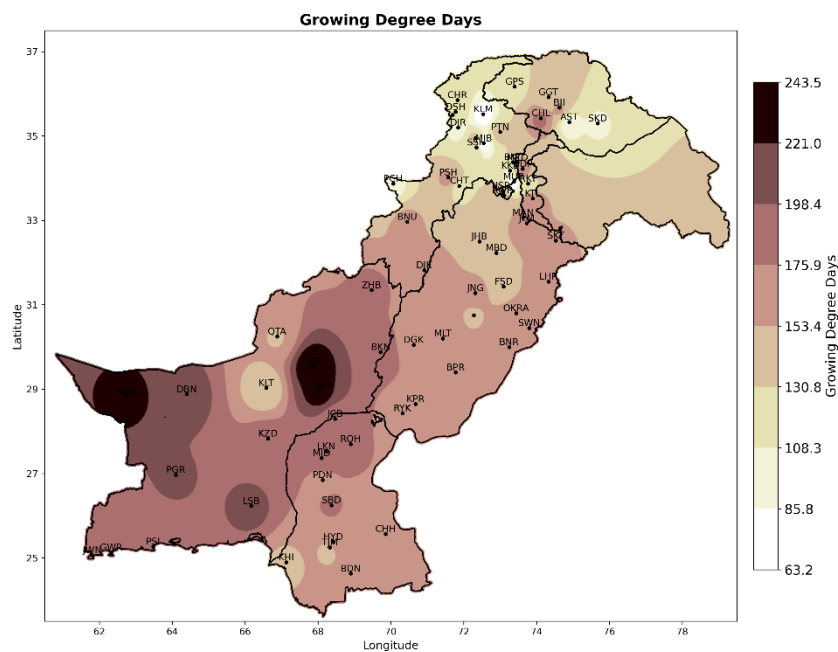
Actual & Departure of Minimum temperature (°C) for the Previous week (08th – 14th June 2026)



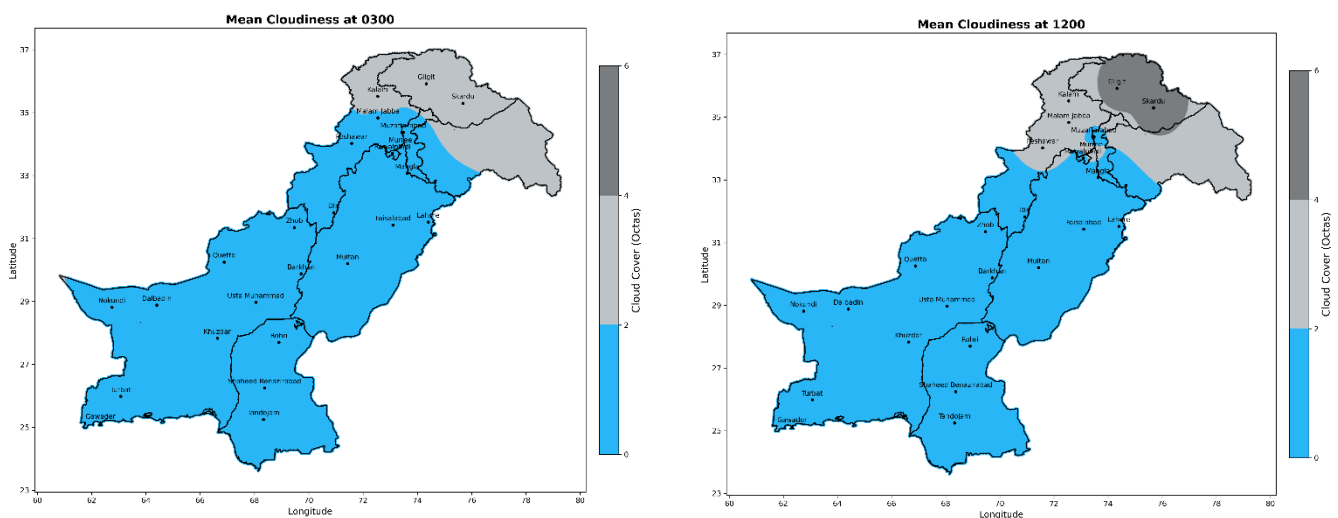
Mean Relative Humidity (%) during the Previous week (08th – 14th June 2026)

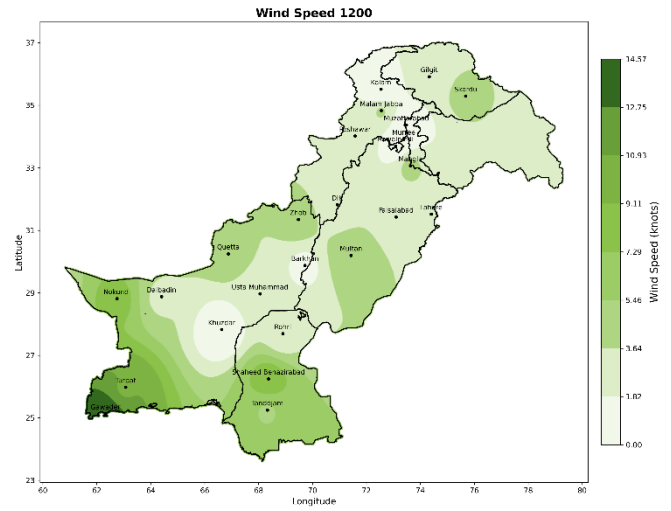
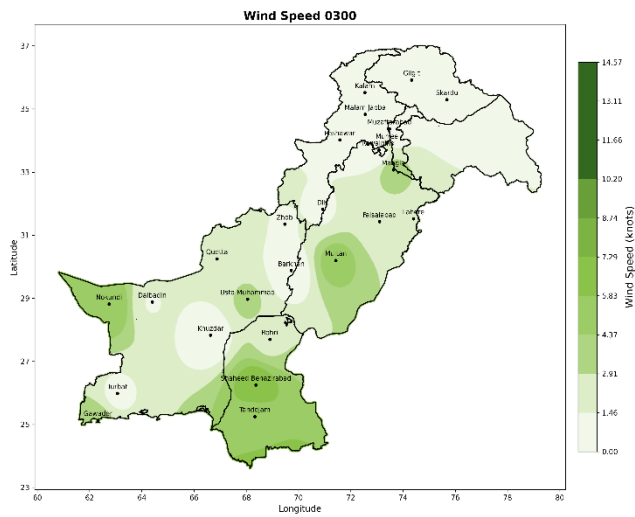


Total Growing Degree Days accumulated during the Previous week (08th – 14th June 2026)



Mean Cloudiness at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (08th – 14th June 2026)

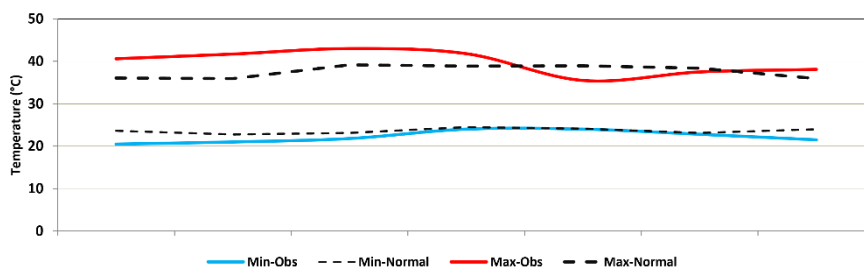


Mean Windspeed at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (08th – 14th June 2026)

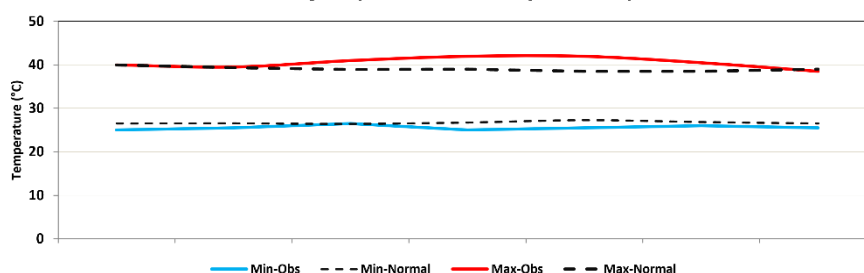
Comparison of temperatures for RAMCs (Minimum & Maximum with normal) during the previous week

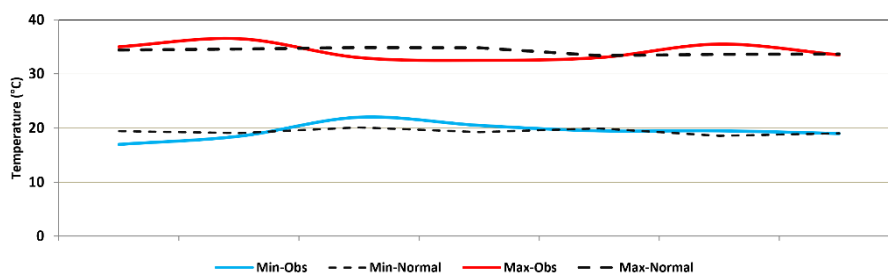
Rawalpindi (Min & Max Temperatures)



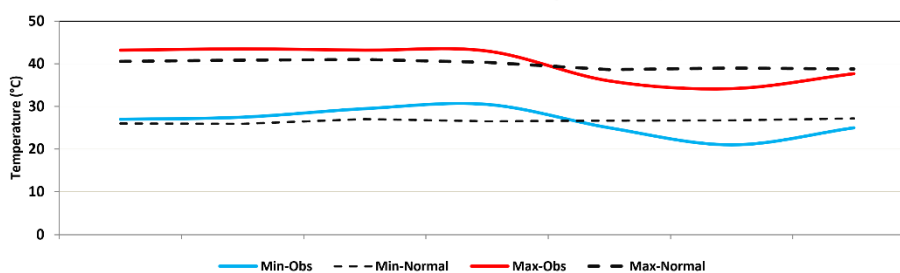
Tandojam (Min & Max Temperatures)



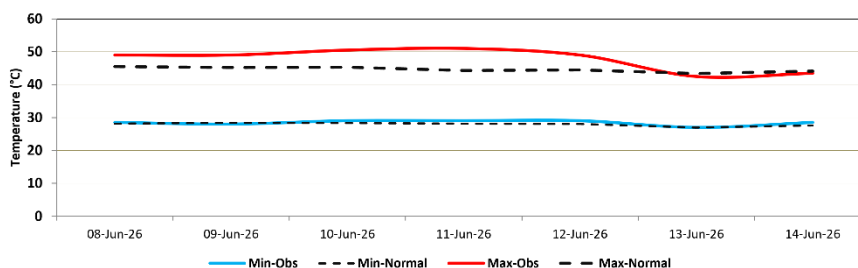
Quetta (Min & Max Temperatures)

Weekly Weather Forecast and Advisory for Farmers**(15th – 21st June 2026)**

A seasonal low lies over north Balochistan and adjoining areas. A ridge of high pressure is present in the upper atmosphere. Moist currents from Arabian sea are also penetrating to the southeastern parts of the country.

MONDAY**15-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Battagram, Kalam and Swat), Kashmir and adjoining hilly areas.

TUESDAY**16-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country, while very hot in central/southern areas during daytime.

WEDNESDAY**17-06-2026**

Rain-thunderstorm is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Punjab and northeast Balochistan. Hot and dry weather is likely elsewhere in the country.

THURSDAY**18-06-2026**

Rain-wind/ thunderstorm is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Punjab, Islamabad and northeast Balochistan. Hot and dry weather is likely elsewhere in the country.

FRIDAY**19-06-2026**

Rain-wind/ thunderstorm is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Punjab, Islamabad and northeast Balochistan. Hot and dry weather is likely elsewhere in the country.

SATURDAY**20-06-2026**

Rain-wind/ thunderstorm is expected in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Murree, Galliat, Khushab, Northeastern Balochistan, Rajanpur, Di Khan and Bahawalpur. Hot and dry weather is likely elsewhere in the country.

SUNDAY**21-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Murree, Galliat, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan.
