

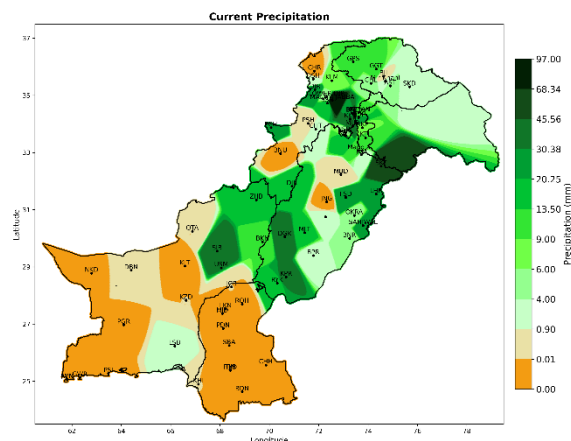
Weekly Weather and Crop Bulletin for Pakistan

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Rainfall Distribution (mm) during the Previous Week (15th – 21st June 2026)



Highlights of Past Weather **(15th – 21st June 2026)**

- Light to moderate rainfall was observed from most parts of Punjab and upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, GB, AJK and northeastern parts of Balochistan. Whereas dry weather was reported from Sindh and southern Balochistan.
- Day time maximum temperatures remained below normal in most parts of the country including Punjab, Sindh, AJK, Eastern parts of KPK and Balochistan.
- Daily minimum temperatures were reported normal to above normal over most parts of the country.

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Punjab

Light to moderate rainfall was observed from most parts of Punjab during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 38.3°C & 25.7°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 145.0 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 51% and wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 3.7/3.9 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 55.50 mm at Sialkot during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.3°C at Bahawalnagar.

Crops: Peanut (Pothohar Region), Maize (Northeastern Punjab), Cotton (Central and Southern Punjab)

Balochistan

Light to moderate rainfall was observed from northeastern parts of the province while dry weather prevailed over the rest parts of the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 37.9°C & 24.9°C respectively. The average relative humidity recorded was 38% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening was recorded 1.7/7.3 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 32.0 mm at Sibbi during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 47.5°C at Nokkundi.

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Light to moderate rainfall was reported from upper parts of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 33.7°C & 20.2°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 119.1 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 61% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 1.1/2.5 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 97.00 mm from Malam Jabba during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 41.0°C at Peshawar.

Crops: Maize

Sindh

Dry weather was reported from the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 40.2°C & 28.1°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 155.1 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 57%, and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 5.8/6.7 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 1.00 mm at Dadu during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 46.5°C at Dadu.

Crops: Cotton

Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir

Light rainfall was reported from Gilgit Baltistan and light to moderate rainfall was reported from Azad Jammu & Kashmir during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 29.8°C & 16.7°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 125.1 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 52%, and mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.0/3.5 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 81.01 mm from Muzaffarabad during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.0°C at Chilas.

Crops: Wheat

Past Weather for Major Agricultural Plains
(15th – 21stS June 2026)

Rawalpindi (Pothohar region)

Rainfall was reported as 16.00 mm from Rawalpindi during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.0/3.8 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity was observed as 57%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 37.9°C & for the recent week, 107.2 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.9/2.0 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.2°C.

**Past Weather for Sub-Regional Agricultural
Plains (15th – 21st June 2026)**

Multan

Rainfall was reported as 13.80 mm from Multan during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded 1.4/1.0 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity observed as 49%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.5°C & for the recent week, 152.4 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 7.7/6.3 Knots.

Lahore

Rainfall was reported as 22.01 mm from Lahore during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.0/3.3 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 45%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.5°C & for the recent week, 159.2 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.3/3.1 Knots.

Zhob

Rainfall was reported as 17.01 mm from Zhob during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 0.6/4.6 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 42%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.1°C & for the recent week, 165.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/8.9 Knots.

Murree

Rainfall was reported as 41.0 mm from Murree during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.4/5.1 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity observed as 59%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 24.3°C & for the recent week, 59.6 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/2.3 Knots.

D.I. Khan

Rainfall was reported as 17.01 mm from D.I Khan during the week, however, cloudiness in the

Rainfall was reported as 29.00 mm from Faisalabad during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.1/1.0 Oktas during the week, average relative humidity was observed as 52%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.2°C & for the recent week, 118.4 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.4/1.1 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.2°C.

Tandojam (Lower Sindh)

Dry weather was reported from Tandojam during the week, however, sky remained clear during the week while average relative humidity recorded as 68%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.4°C & for the recent week, 117.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 5.4/6.6 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 37.0°C.

Usta Muhammad (Eastern Baluchistan)

Rainfall was reported as 0.01 mm (Trace) from Usta Muhammad during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.0/3.0 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 46%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 43.6°C. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.8/3.7 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 45.0°C.

Quetta (Northern Baluchistan)

Rainfall was reported as 0.01 mm (Trace) from Quetta during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 0.7/3.8 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 24%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 34.7°C. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.7/3.8 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 37.0°C.

morning/evening recorded as 1.1/1.6 Oktas. Average relative humidity was observed as 59%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.4°C & for the recent week, 160.2 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.3/2.3 Knots.

Peshawar

Rainfall was reported as 0.30 mm from Peshawar during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 0.4/4.0 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 47%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.3°C & for the recent week, 155.9 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.4/4.7 Knots.

Kalam

Rainfall was reported as 7.01 mm from Kalam during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.1/5.7 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 42%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 24.1°C & for the recent week, 57.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.9/4.1 Knots.

Gilgit

Rainfall was reported as 9.61 mm from Gilgit during the week; cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.1/5.0 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 48%. Mean day time temperature recorded as 30.5°C & for the recent week, 129.9 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/4.6 Knots.

Skardu

Rainfall was reported as 1.81 mm from Skardu during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 6.1/5.7 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed

as 42%. The mean day time temperature recorded as 27.6°C & for the recent week, 104.9 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.6/4.1 Knots.

Crop Situation for Major Agricultural Plains (Based on data from Regional Agromet Centers)

Pothohar Region (Rawalpindi)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Rawalpindi.

Central Punjab (Faisalabad)

Cotton crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Faisalabad. Phonological Stage: Budding completed. Condition: *Very Good*.

Lower Sindh (Tandojam)

Cotton crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Tandojam. Phonological Stage: Budding. Condition: *Good*.

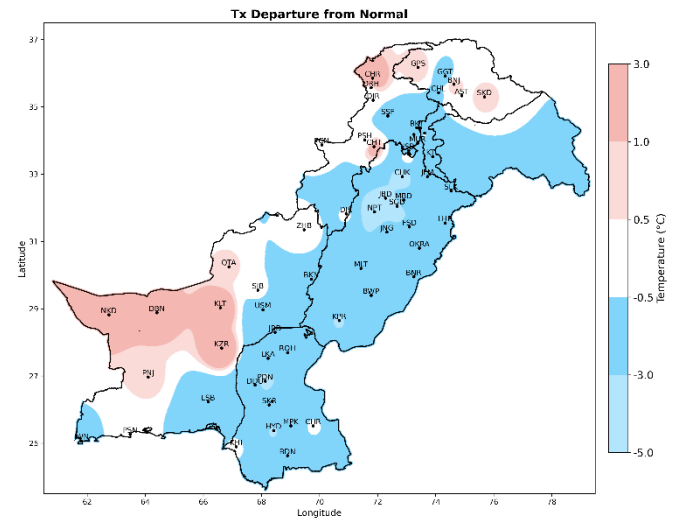
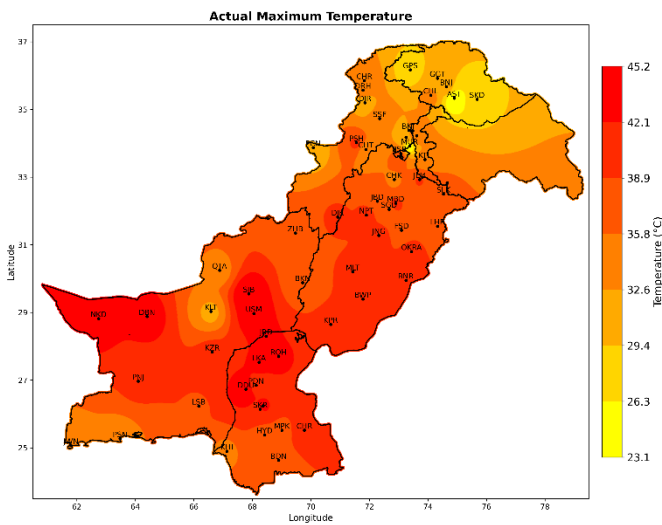
Northern Baluchistan (Quetta)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Quetta.

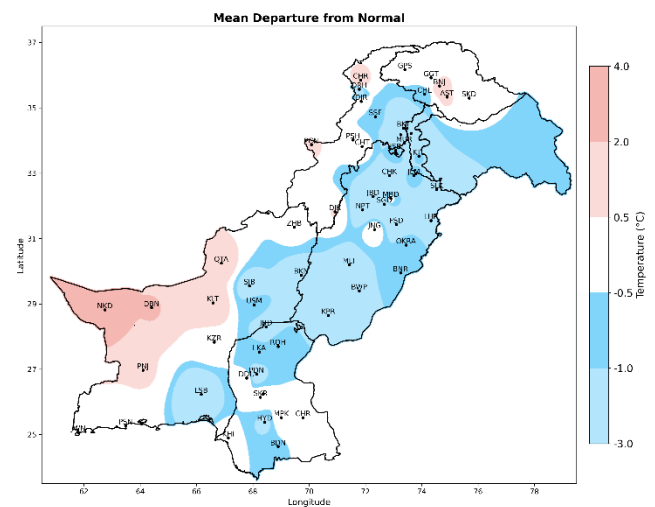
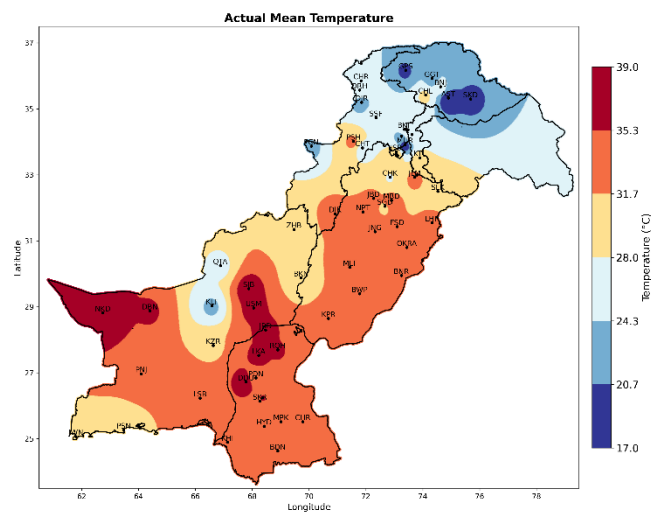
Eastern Baluchistan (Usta Muhammad)

Field is being prepared for rice pinery.

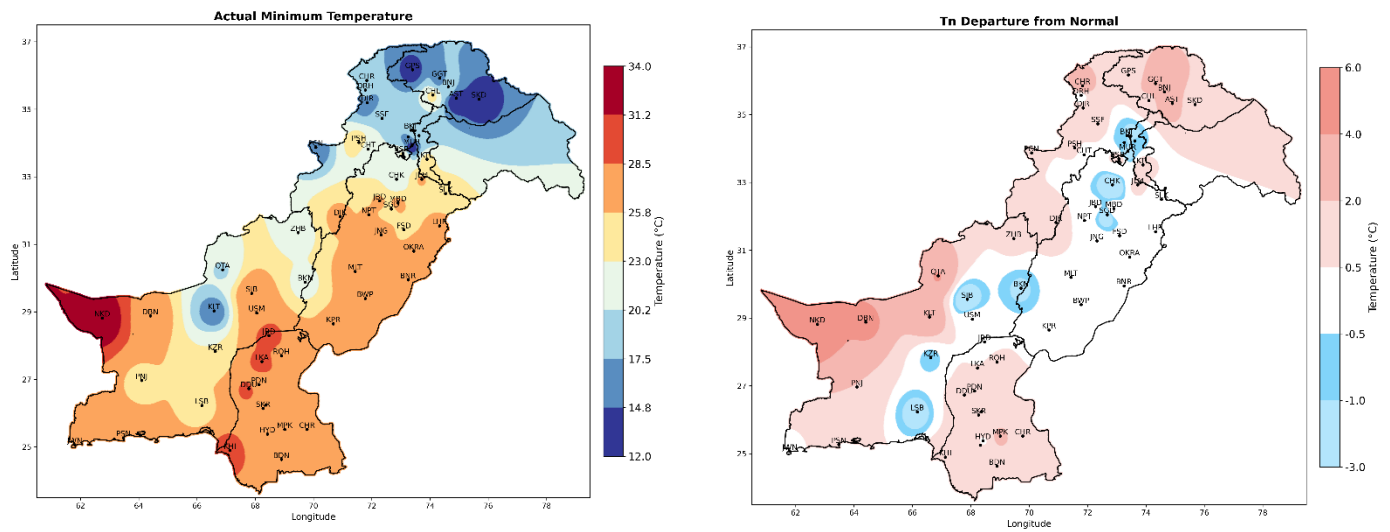
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (15th – 21st June 2026)



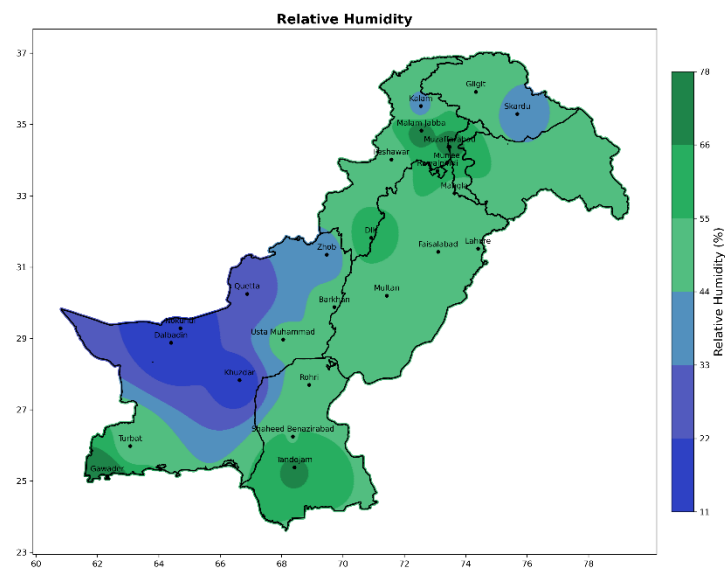
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (15th – 21st June 2026)



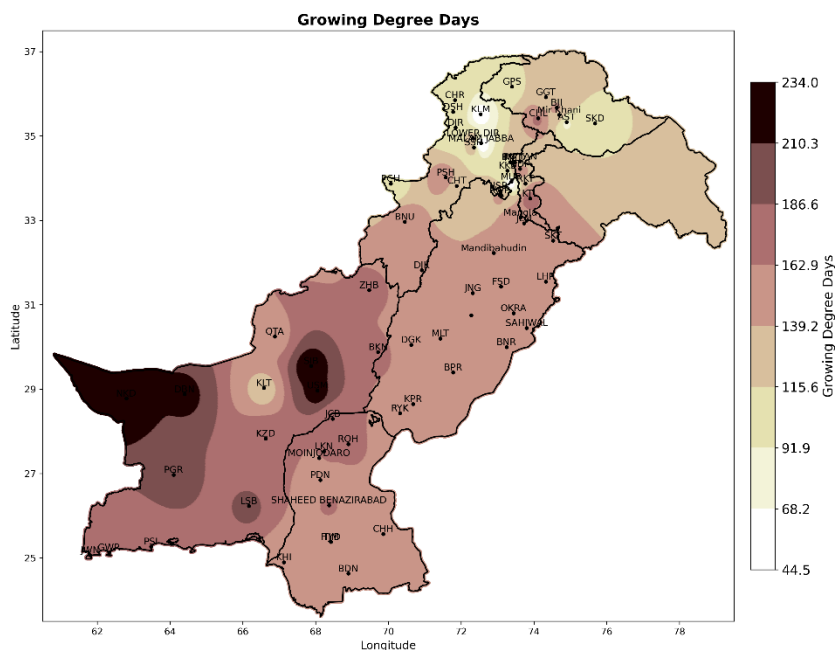
Actual & Departure of Minimum temperature ($^{\circ}\text{C}$) for the Previous week (15th – 21st June 2026)



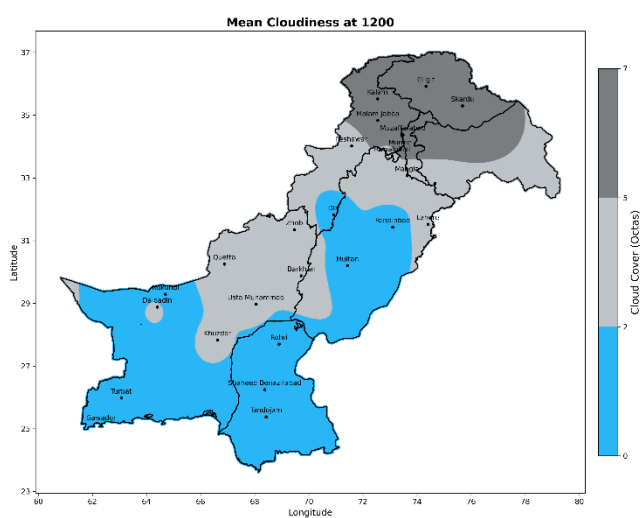
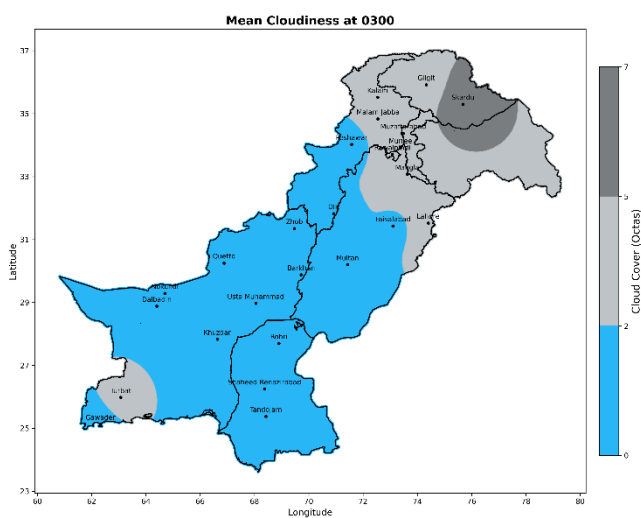
Mean Relative Humidity (%) during the Previous week (15th – 21st June 2026)

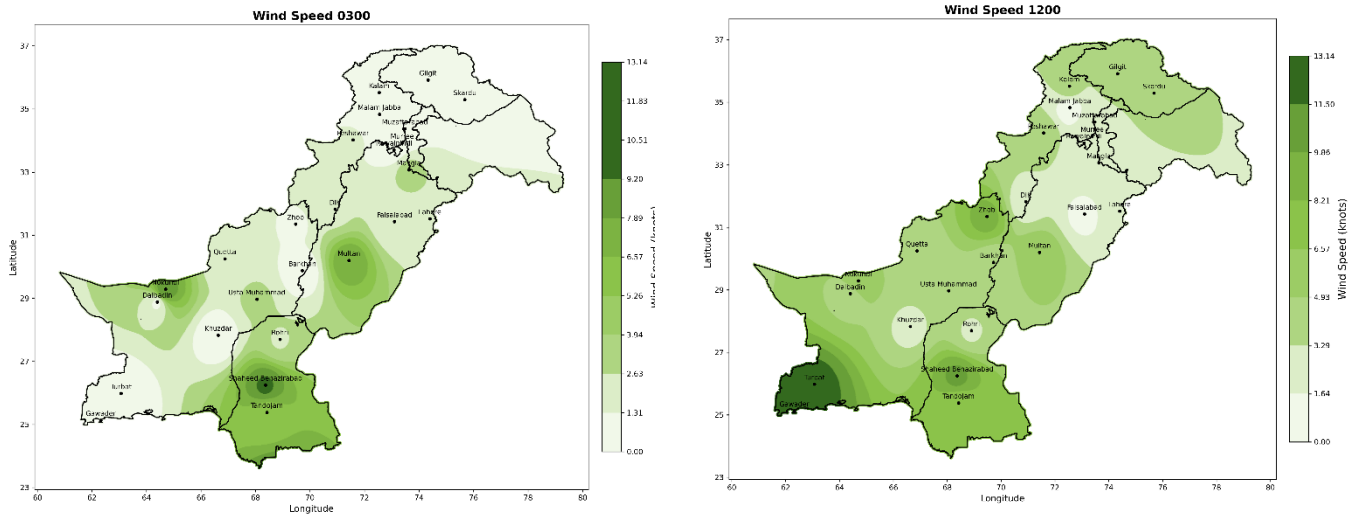


Total Growing Degree Days accumulated during the Previous week (15th – 21st June 2026)



Mean Cloudiness at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (15th – 21st June 2026)

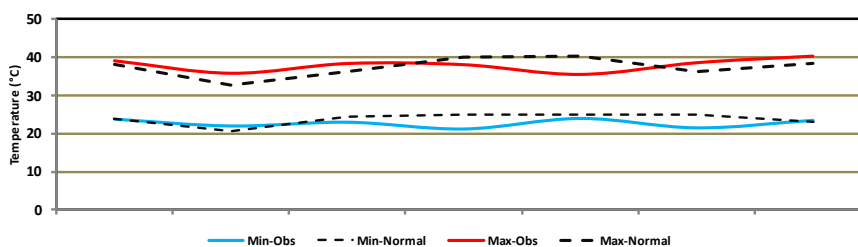


Mean Windspeed at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (15th – 21st June 2026)

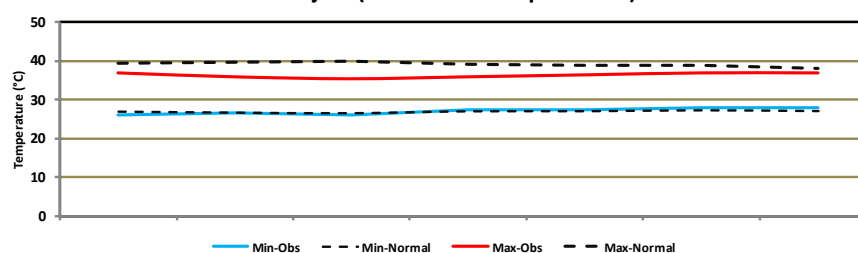
Comparison of temperatures for RAMCs (Minimum & Maximum with normal) during the previous week

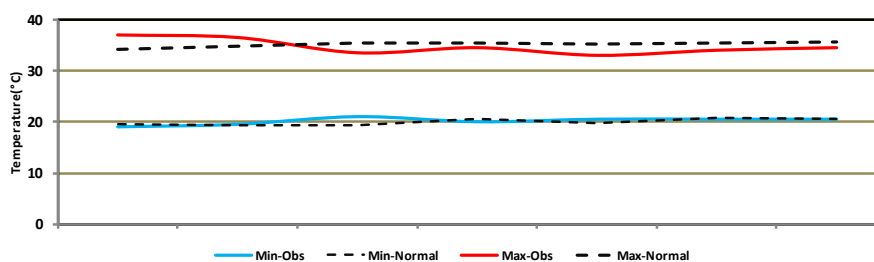
Rawalpindi (Min & Max Temperatures)



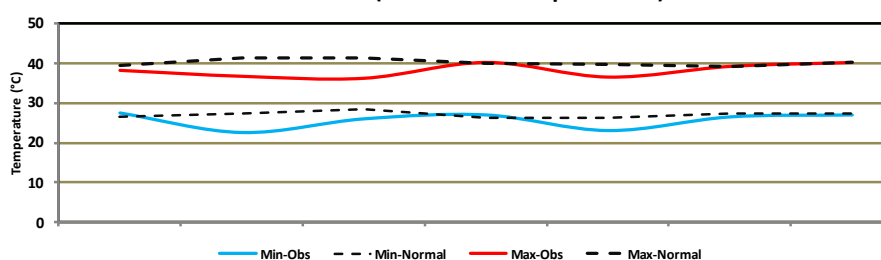
Tandojam (Min & Max Temperatures)



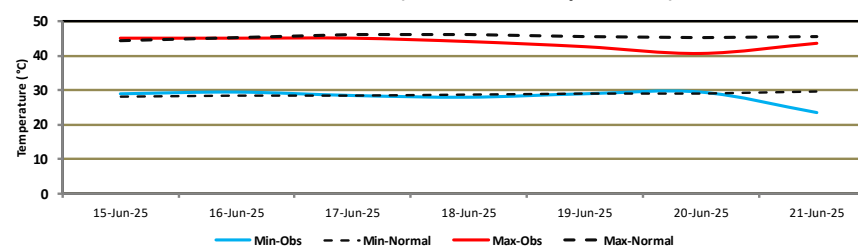
Quetta (Min & Max Temperatures)

Weekly Weather Forecast and Advisory for Farmers**(22nd – 28th June 2026)**

A seasonal low lies over north Balochistan and adjoining areas. A ridge of high pressure is present in the upper atmosphere. Moist currents from Arabian sea are also penetrating to the southeastern parts of the country.

MONDAY**22-06-2026**

Rain-windstorm/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa(Khyber, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Parachinar, Hangu and Kurram), Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan and Punjab (Rawalpindi, Murree, Galiyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar, Layyah, Mianwali, Kasur, Okara, Jhang, Faisalabad, Multan, D.G. Khan, Rajanpur, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Vehari, Khanewal, Rahim Yar Khan) and upper Sindh(Jacobabad, Larkana, Dadu, Nowshera Feroze, Shaheed Benazirabad, Sukkur, Ghotki). Moderate to heavy rain is also likely at few places in central/southern Punjab, Kashmir.

TUESDAY**23-06-2026**

Hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country. However, rain-windstorm/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa(Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Parachinar), Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan and northeastern Punjab(Murree, Galiyat, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Khanewal).

WEDNESDAY**24-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country while very hot in southern parts. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Kashmir and adjoining hilly areas.

THURSDAY**25-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Gilgit Baltistan, Kashmir, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and northeastern Punjab.

FRIDAY**26-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Gilgit Baltistan, Kashmir, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, northeastern Punjab and northeastern Balochistan.

SATURDAY**27-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Gilgit Baltistan, Kashmir, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, northeastern Punjab.

SUNDAY**28-06-2026**

Mainly hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the country. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Gilgit Baltistan, Kashmir, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
