

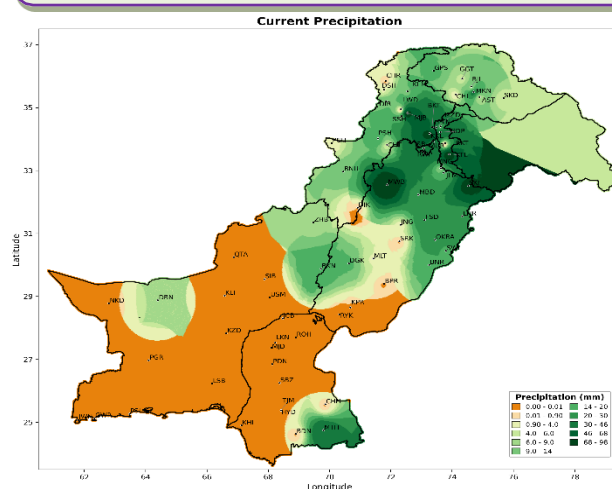

Highlights of Past Weather (06th July – 12th July 2026)

- Light to moderate rainfall was observed over the upper parts particularly upper and central Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Azad Jammu and Kashmir. Isolated heavyfalls were also reported from a few scattered places including southeastern parts of Sindh during the previous week. Whereas, dry weather was reported from most parts of Balochistan, Sindh along the adjoining areas of southern Punjab.
- Daily temperatures including (maximum, minimum and mean temperatures) remained above normal in most parts of the country.

Punjab

Light to moderate rainfall (along with an isolated heavy fall) was reported from the upper and central parts of the Province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 38.1°C & 27.2°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 150.3 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 66% and wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 3.5/3.5 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 89.00 mm at Mianwali during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 46.0°C at Bhakkar.

Crops: Peanut (Pothohar Region), Rice (Northeastern Punjab), Cotton (Central and Southern Punjab)

Balochistan

Light rainfall was observed from a few scattered places of the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 39.4°C & 26.4°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 195.3 growing degree days were accumulated. The average relative humidity recorded was 35% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.9/7.0 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 19.00 mm at Barkhan during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 48.5°C at Turbat.

Crop: Wheat

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Light to moderate rainfall (along with an isolated heavy fall) was reported from the most parts of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 34.6°C & 22.2°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 128.2 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 62% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 0.6/4.4 Knots.

The highest total rainfall was recorded as 98.00 mm from Kakul during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.5°C at Bannu.

Crop: Maize

Sindh

Isolated heavy rainfall was reported from the southeastern part of Sindh. While, dry weather prevailed over the rest of the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 40.6°C & 28.5°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 158.2 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 58%, and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 6.2/6.9 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 45.00 mm at Mithi during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 47.5°C at Dadu.

Crop: Cotton

Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir

Light rainfall was reported from Gilgit Baltistan and light to moderate rainfall (along with an isolated heavy fall) was reported from Azad Jammu & Kashmir during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 33.1°C & 19.0°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 139.9 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 53%, and mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.5/2.9 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 82.00 mm from Kotli during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 42.5°C at Chilas.

Crop: Wheat

Past Weather for Major Agricultural Plains
(06th July – 12th July 2026)

Rawalpindi (Pothohar region)

Rainfall was reported as 34.80 mm from Rawalpindi during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.0/4.3 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity was observed as 63%. The mean day time

temperature was recorded as 38.1°C & for the recent week, 114.1 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.5/2.0 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.0°C.

Faisalabad (Central Punjab)

Rainfall was reported as 27.40 mm from Faisalabad during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.4/3.4 Oktas during the week, average relative humidity was observed as 65%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.0°C & for the recent week, 149.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.9/2.9 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 41.0°C.

Tandojam (Lower Sindh)

Dry weather was reported from Tandojam during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.1/0.5 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity recorded as 69%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 37.9°C & for the recent week, 141.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 4.8/6.3 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 39.0°C.

Usta Muhammad (Eastern Baluchistan)

Dry weather was reported from Usta Muhammad during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.6/1.4 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 51%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 44.0°C & for the recent week, 187.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Rice crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.2/4.0 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 46.5°C.

Quetta (Northern Baluchistan)

Dry weather was reported from Quetta during the

week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 0.0/2.2 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 27%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.7°C & for the recent week, 169.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.5/4.4 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 38.0°C.

Past Weather for Sub-Regional Agricultural Plains (06th July – 12th July 2026)

Multan

Rainfall was reported as 3.90 mm from Multan during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded 2.4/1.3 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity observed as 52%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 40.6°C & for the recent week, 162.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 6.9/7.1 Knots.

Lahore

Rainfall was reported as 21.20 mm from Lahore during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 5.0/5.3 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 67%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.3°C & for the recent week, 148.2 growing degree days were accumulated for Rice crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.6/2.0 Knots.

Zhob

Rainfall was reported as 8.00 mm from Zhob during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 0.6/3.6 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 40%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.6°C & for the recent week, 187.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.7/4.6 Knots.

Murree

Rainfall was reported as 38.00 mm from Murree during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.1/5.7 Oktas during the week, while

average relative humidity observed as 79%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 25.0°C & for the recent week, 72.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/1.4 Knots.

D.I. Khan

Dry weather was reported from D.I Khan during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 1.1/1.1 Oktas. Average relative humidity was observed as 58%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 40.6°C & for the recent week, 172.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.6/0.6 Knots.

Peshawar

Rainfall was reported as 17.40 mm from Peshawar during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 2.6/4.9 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 62%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.5°C & for the recent week, 161.6 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.4/7.7 Knots.

Kalam

Rainfall was reported as 13.00 mm from Kalam during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 1.9/6.6 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 42%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 26.9°C & for the recent week, 77.7 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.6/3.4 Knots.

Gilgit

Rainfall was reported as 5.00 mm from Gilgit during the week; cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.0/5.9 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 45%. Mean day time temperature recorded as 35.2°C & for the recent week,

159.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.7/4.6 Knots.

Skardu

Rainfall was reported as 4.40 mm from Skardu during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.4/6.6 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 42%. The mean day time temperature recorded as 30.5°C & for the recent week, 130.6 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/3.4 Knots.

Pothohar Region (Rawalpindi)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Rawalpindi.

Central Punjab (Faisalabad)

Northern Baluchistan (Quetta)

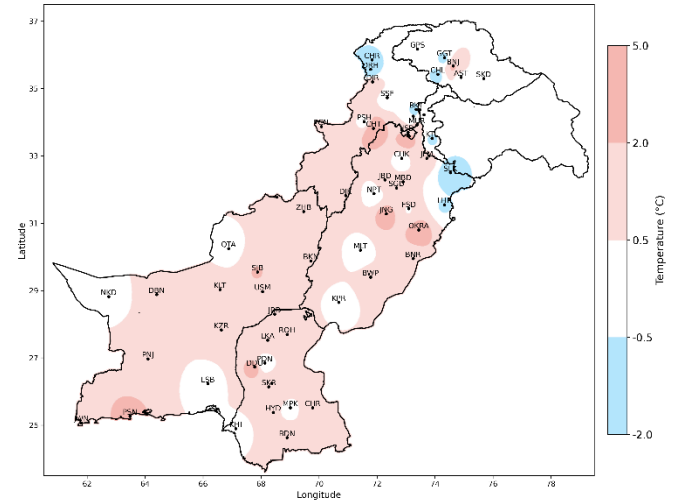
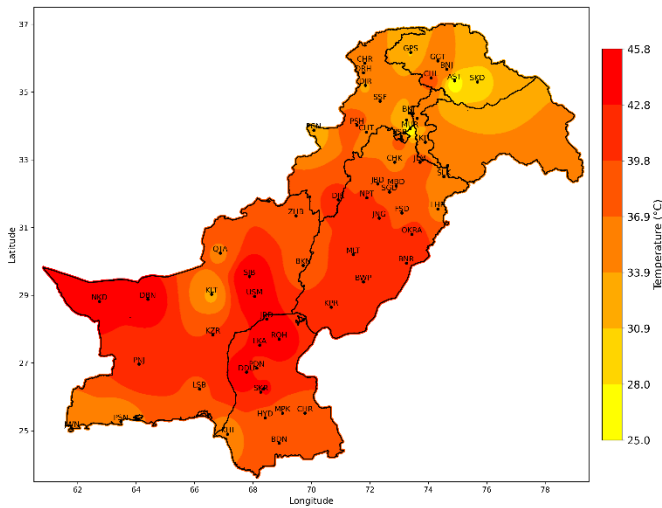
There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Quetta.

Eastern Baluchistan (Usta Muhammad)

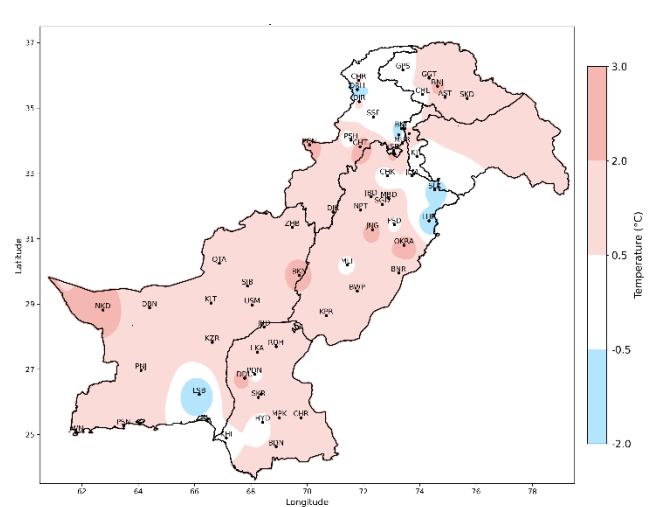
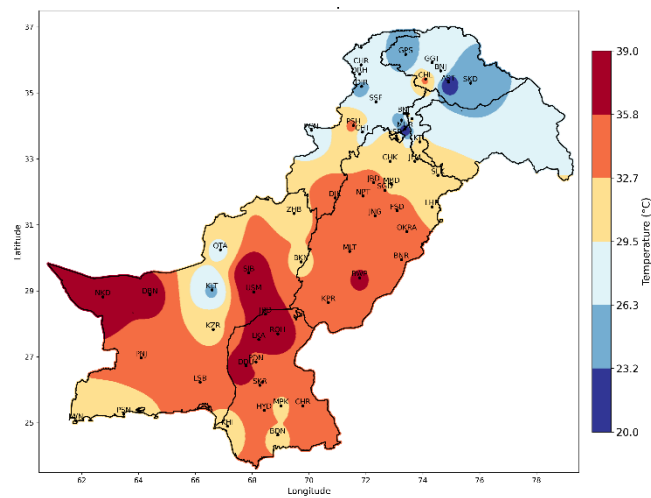
Rice crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Usta Muhammad. Phonological Stage: Germination.

Condition: *Good*.

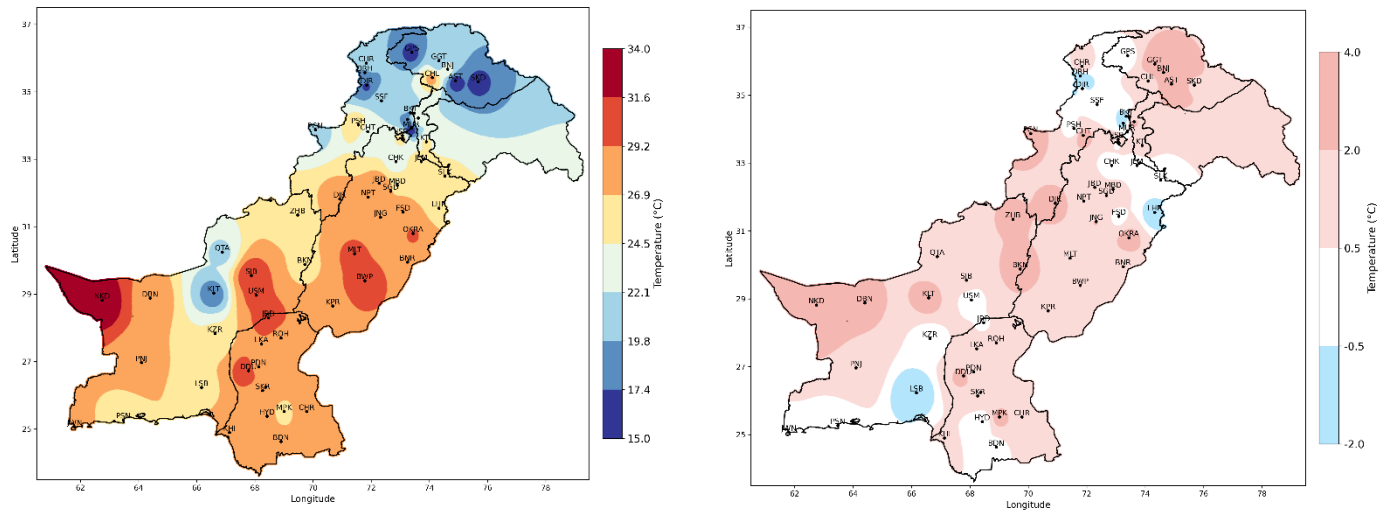
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (06th July – 12th July 2026)



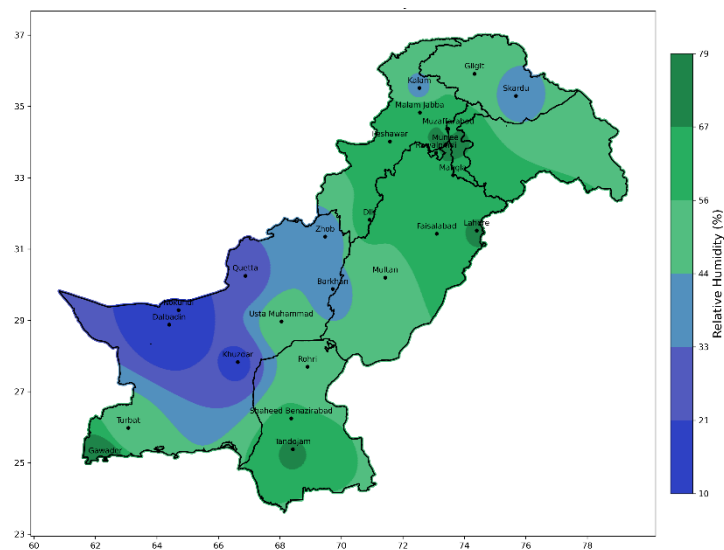
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (06th July – 12th July 2026)



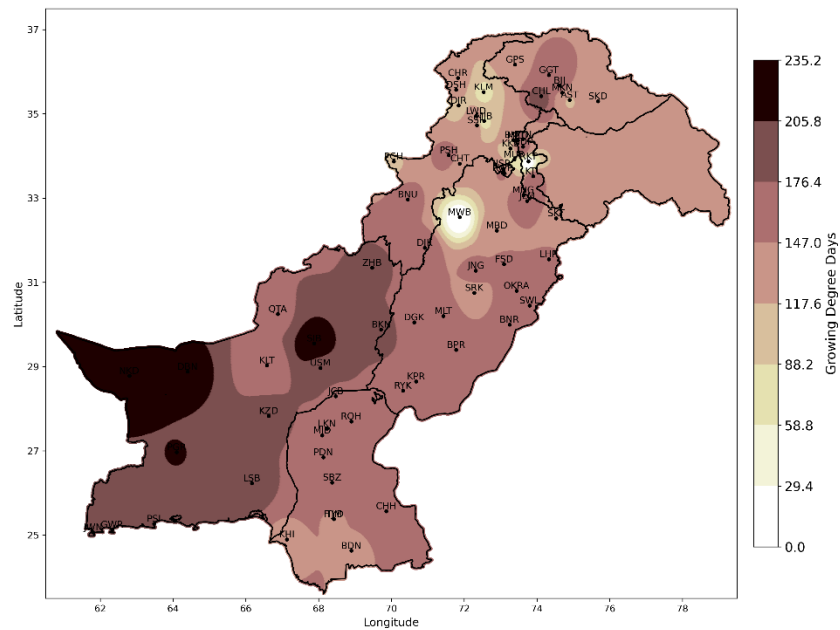
Actual & Departure of Minimum temperature ($^{\circ}\text{C}$) for the Previous week (06th July – 12th July 2026)



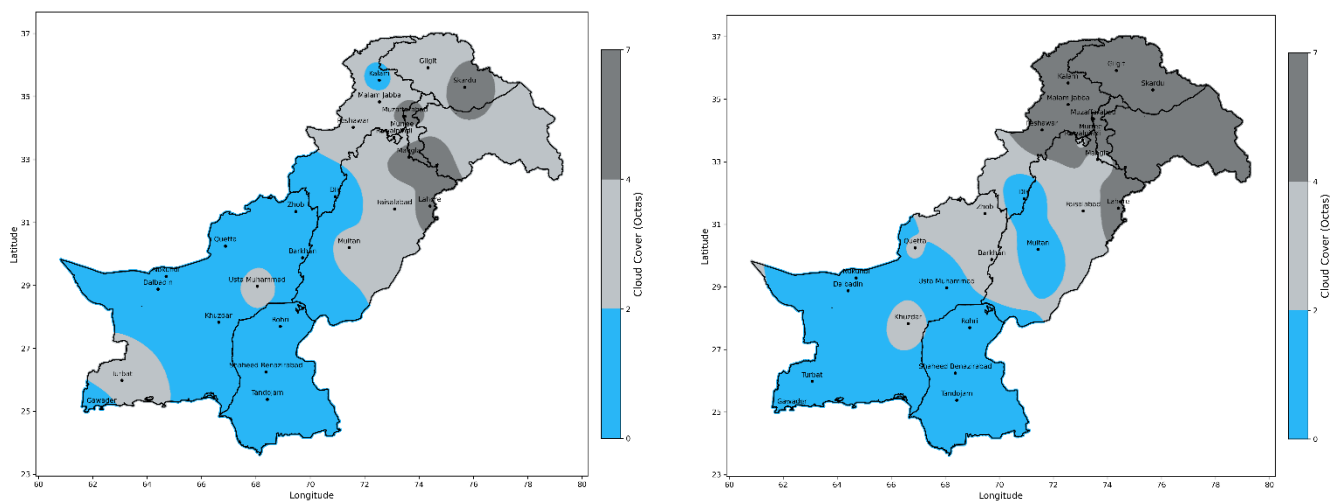
Mean Relative Humidity (%) during the Previous week (06th July – 12th July 2026)

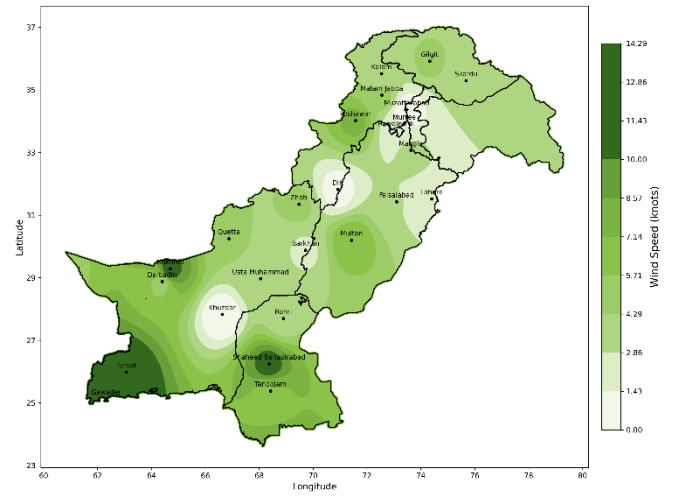
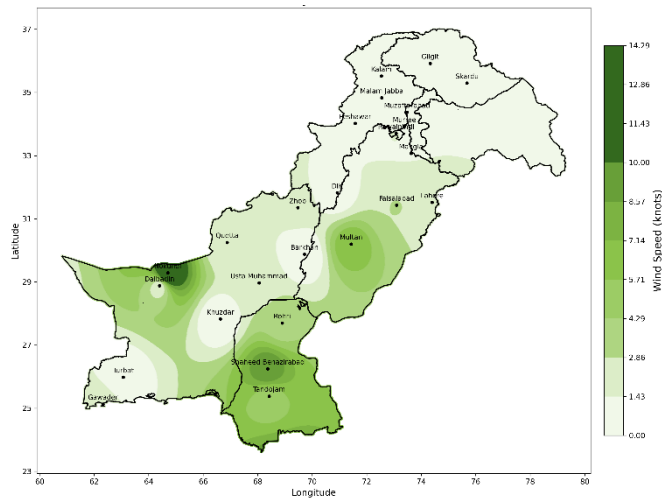


Total Growing Degree Days accumulated during the Previous week (06th July – 12th July 2026)



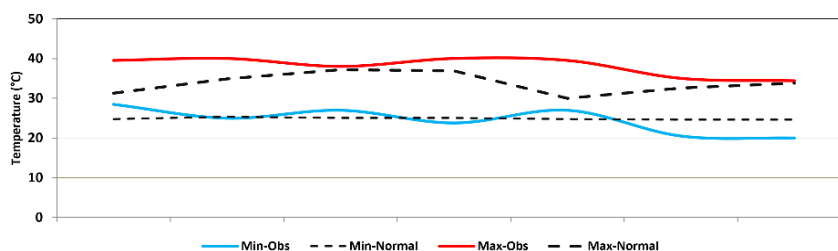
Mean Cloudiness at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (06th July – 12th July 2026)



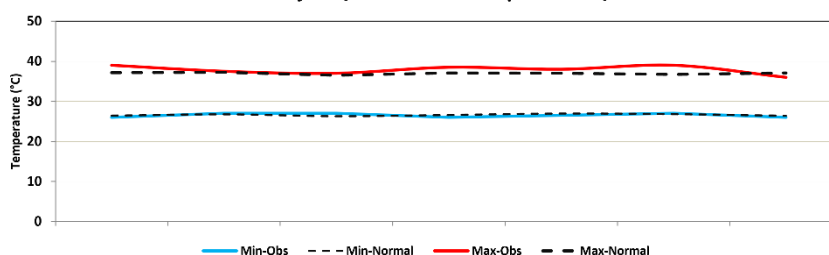
Mean Windspeed at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (06th July – 12th July 2026)

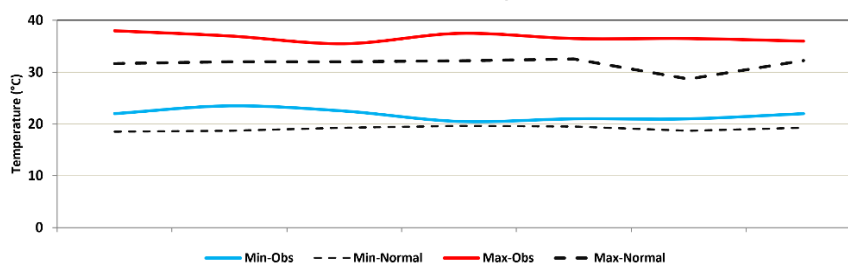
Rawalpindi (Min & Max Temperatures)



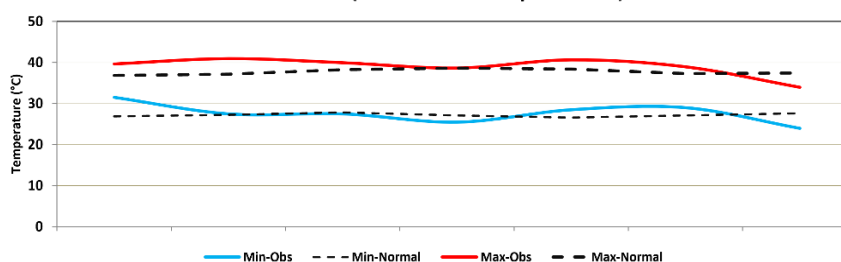
Tandojam (Min & Max Temperatures)



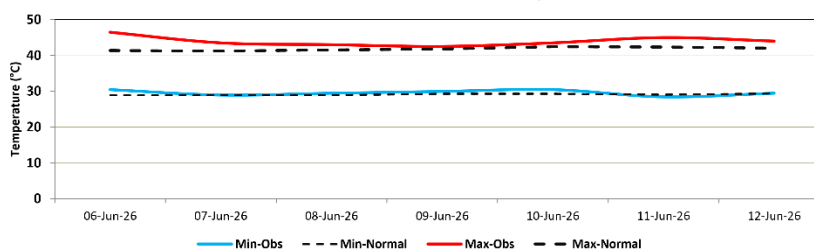
Quetta (Min & Max Temperatures)

Weekly Weather Forecast and Advisory for Farmers**(13th –19th July 2026)**

Strong moist currents from the Arabian Sea are continuously penetrating in the upper and lower parts of the country. Meanwhile, a westerly wave is also affecting parts of the country.

MONDAY**13-07-2026**

Hot and humid weather is expected to prevail over most parts of the country. However, Rain-wind/thundershowers is expected in Kashmir, Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, northeast Punjab, eastern Sindh and Gilgit-Baltistan during evening/night.

TUESDAY**14-07-2026**

Hot and humid weather is expected to prevail over most parts of the country. However, Rain-wind/thundershowers is expected in Kashmir, Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Northeast Punjab, eastern Sindh and Gilgit-Baltistan.

WEDNESDAY**15-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected over most parts of the country. Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Kashmir, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

THURSDAY**16-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected over most parts of the country.

FRIDAY**17-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected over most parts of the country.

SATURDAY**18-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected over most parts of the country-Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pothohar region and Kashmir.

SUNDAY**19-07-2026**

Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls) is expected in upper Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Kashmir. Rain-wind/thunderstorm is also likely at isolated places in northeast Balochistan.
