

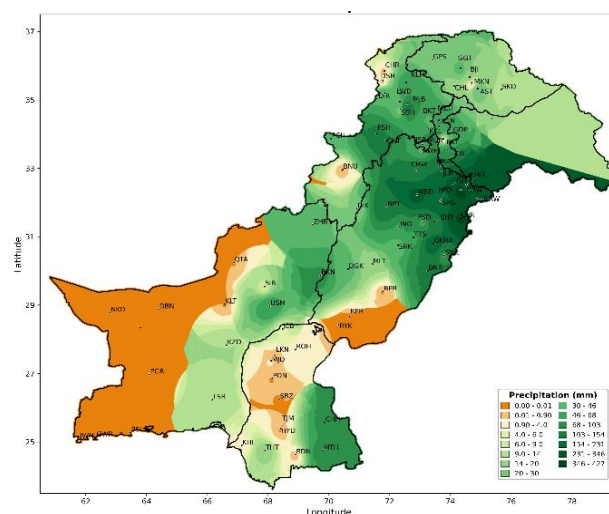
Weekly Weather and Crop Bulletin for Pakistan

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Rainfall Distribution (mm) during the Previous Week (20th – 26th July 2026)



Highlights of Past Weather (20th – 26th July 2026)

- Moderate to heavy rainfall was observed over Punjab particularly northeastern Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Azad Jammu and Kashmir and southeastern Sindh. Whereas, light to moderate rainfall was reported from most parts of Gilgit Baltistan and eastern Balochistan.
- Dry weather was reported from western parts of Balochistan and isolated locations of southern Punjab and Sindh.
- Day time maximum temperatures remained normal to below normal in most parts of the country except western parts of Balochistan where above normal temperatures were recorded.

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Punjab

Heavy rainfall was observed from the scattered places of upper Punjab particularly the northeastern parts of the province while light to moderate rainfall was reported from rest of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 33.0°C & 26.0°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 124.1 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 80% and wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 2.7/3.4 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 426.90 mm at Gujranwala during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.0°C at Bhakkar.

Crops: Peanut (Pothohar Region), Rice (Northeastern Punjab), Cotton (Central and Southern Punjab)

Balochistan

Light to moderate rainfall was observed from the northeastern and eastern belt of the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 37.4°C & 25.6°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 185.0 growing degree days were accumulated. The average relative humidity recorded was 43% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening was recorded 3.4/7.1 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 71.00 mm at Barkhan during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 47.5°C at Nokkundi and Dalbandin.

Crops: Wheat

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Light to moderate rainfall (along with isolated heavy falls) was reported from most parts of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 31.2°C & 22.0°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 110.1 growing degree days were accumulated.

Average relative humidity recorded as 80% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 1.3/1.8 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 147.00 mm from Malamjabba during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.5°C at D.I Khan.

Crop: Maize

Sindh

Light to moderate rainfall (along with isolated heavy falls) was observed from the southeastern parts of the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 37.2°C & 27.6°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 142.7 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 66%, and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 3.3/4.4 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 82.20 mm at Mithi during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 41.5°C at Nawabshah.

Crop: Cotton

Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir

Light to moderate rainfall (along with isolated heavy falls) was reported from Gilgit Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 28.9°C & 20.1°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 136.9 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 77%, and mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.2/3.2 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 73.00 mm from Kotli during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 44.0°C at Chilas.

Crop: Wheat

Past Weather for Major Agricultural Plains
(20th – 26th July 2026)

Rawalpindi (Pothohar region)

Rainfall was reported as 39.70 mm from Rawalpindi during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 7.4/5.8 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity was observed as 77%. The mean day time

temperature was recorded as 32.9°C & for the recent week, 124.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.4/0.8 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 38.0°C.

Faisalabad (Central Punjab)

Rainfall was reported as 64.40 from Faisalabad during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 5.4/6.1 Oktas during the week, average relative humidity was observed as 81%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 33.5°C & for the recent week, 128.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.3/2.3 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.5°C.

Tandojam (Lower Sindh)

Dry weather was reported from Tandojam during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 5.3/3.7 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity recorded as 75%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 35.9°C & for the recent week, 133.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/0.9 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 39.0°C.

Usta Muhammad (Eastern Baluchistan)

Rainfall was reported as 67.0 mm from Usta Muhammad during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 6.0/2.7 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 63%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.3°C & for the recent week, 146.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 3.7/4.2 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.5°C.

Quetta (Northern Baluchistan)

Rainfall was reported as 0.01 mm (Trace) from

Quetta during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.8/4.1 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 40%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 35.3°C & for the recent week, 163.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 3.1/5.3 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 38.0°C.

Past Weather for Sub-Regional Agricultural Plains (20th – 26th July 2026)

Multan

Rainfall was reported as 14.00 mm from Multan during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded 6.1/3.9 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity observed as 65%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.9°C & for the recent week, 146.7 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 6.3/6.3 Knots.

Lahore

Rainfall was reported as 356.50 mm from Lahore during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 7.2/6.7 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 85%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 31.3°C & for the recent week, 114.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Rice crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.7/1.7 Knots.

Zhob

Rainfall was reported as 34.00 mm from Zhob during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.4/4.0 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 55%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 34.6°C & for the recent week, 167.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.0/7.1 Knots.

Rainfall was reported as 119.00 mm from Murree during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 8.0/7.6 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity observed as 89%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 21.1°C & for the recent week, 55.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.3/2.3 Knots.

D.I. Khan

Rainfall was reported as 21.00 mm from D.I Khan during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 4.4/3.1 Oktas. Average relative humidity was observed as 70%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 35.8°C & for the recent week, 149.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.7/1.7 Knots.

Peshawar

Rainfall was reported as 109.50 mm from Peshawar during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 6.7/5.4 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 81%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 33.7°C & for the recent week, 136.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.4/2.6 Knots.

Kalam

Rainfall was reported as 55.90 mm from Kalam during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 5.9/7.3 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 64%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 23.9°C & for the recent week, 70.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/0.6 Knots.

Rainfall was reported as 34.30 mm from Gilgit during the week; cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 7.1/7.0 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 74%. Mean day time temperature recorded as 30.9°C & for the recent week, 143.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 7.4/9.4 Knots.

Skardu

Rainfall was reported as 11.50 from Skardu during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 6.6/7.3 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 64%. The mean day time temperature recorded as 27.3°C & for the recent week, 122.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/0.6 Knots.

Crop Situation for Major Agricultural Plains (Based on data from Regional Agromet Centers)

Pothohar Region (Rawalpindi)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Rawalpindi.

Central Punjab (Faisalabad)

Cotton crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Faisalabad. Phonological Stage: Flowering completed.

Lower Sindh (Tandojam)

Cotton crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Tandojam. Phonological Stage: Flowering.

Condition: *Good*.

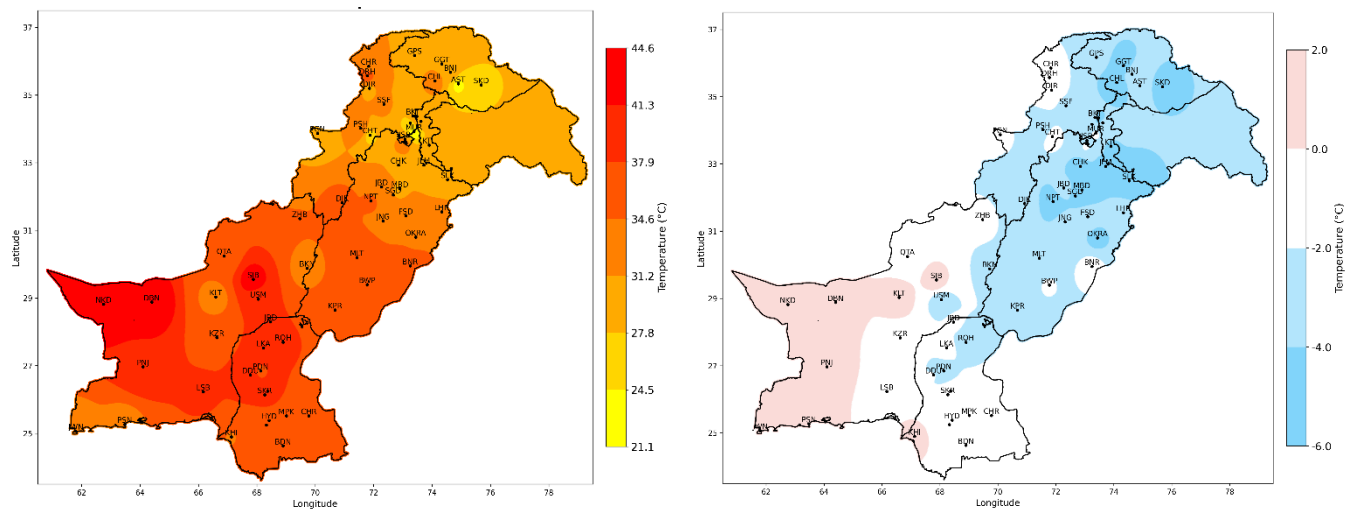
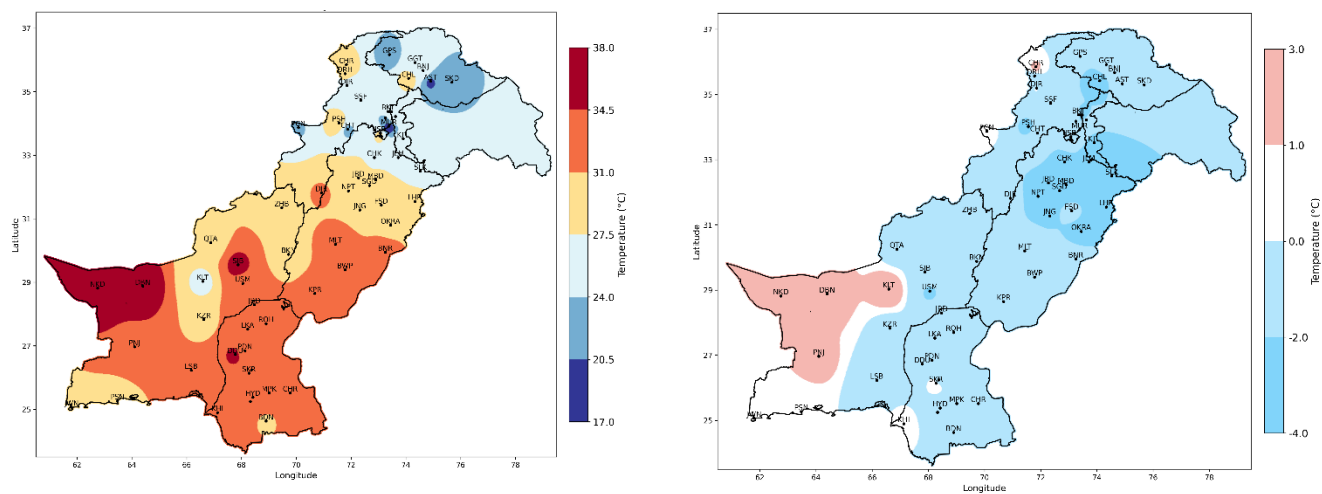
Northern Baluchistan (Quetta)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Quetta.

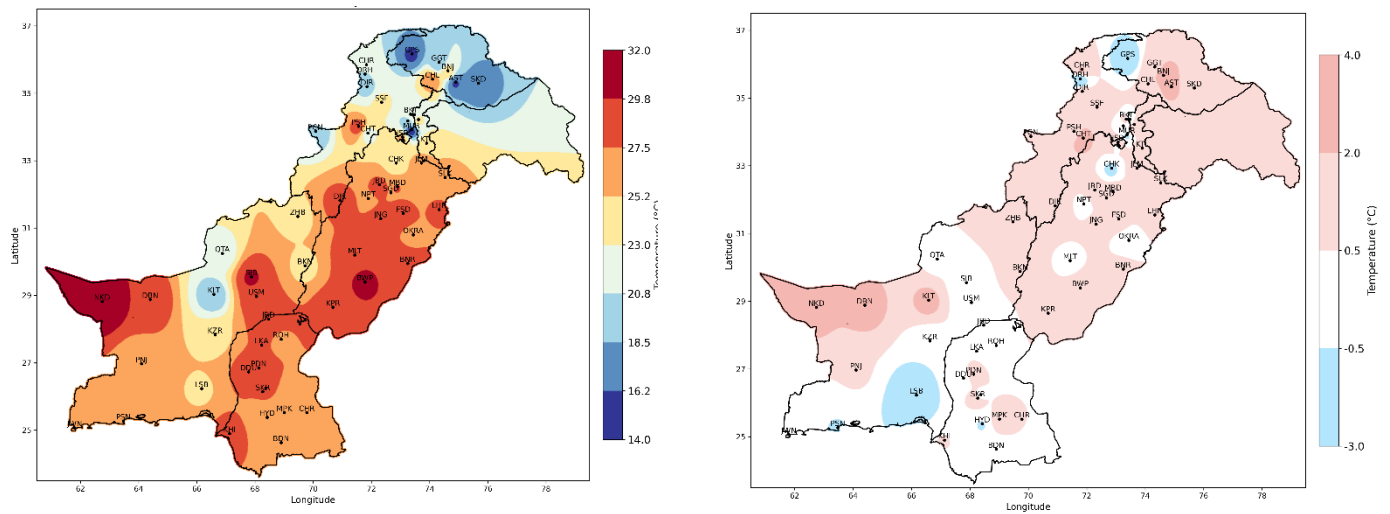
Eastern Baluchistan (Usta Muhammad)

Rice crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Usta Muhammad. Phonological Stage: Emerging

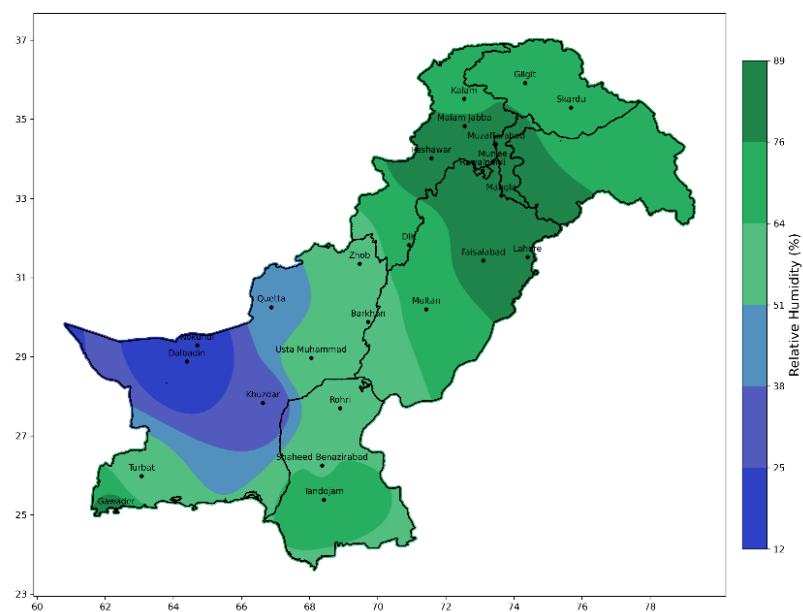

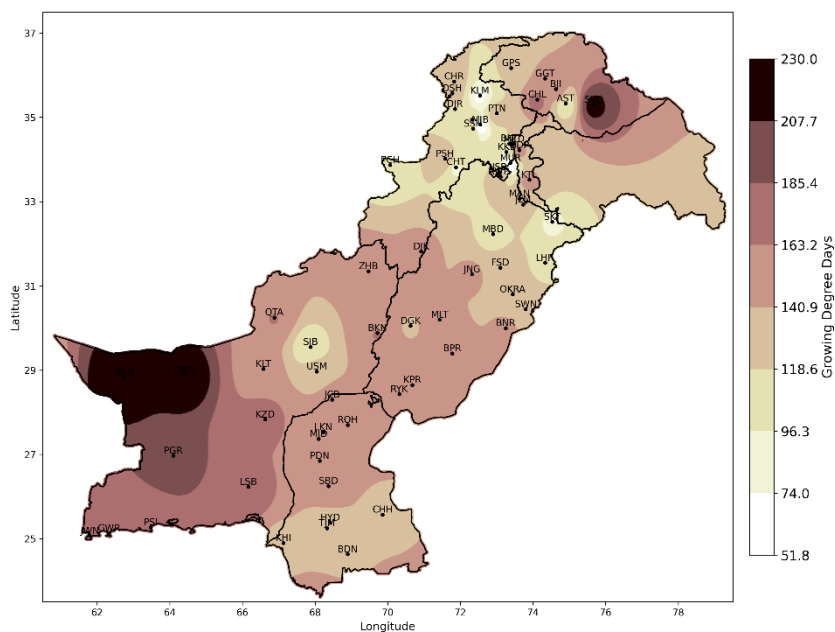
Actual & Departure of Minimum temperature ($^{\circ}\text{C}$) for the Previous week (20th – 26th July 2026))



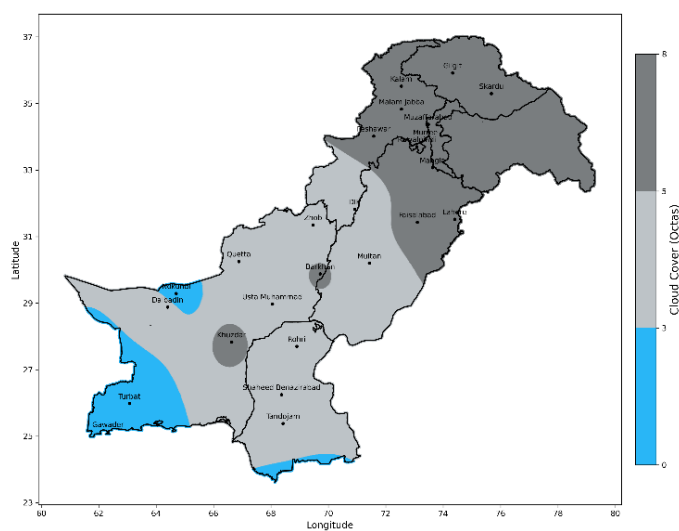
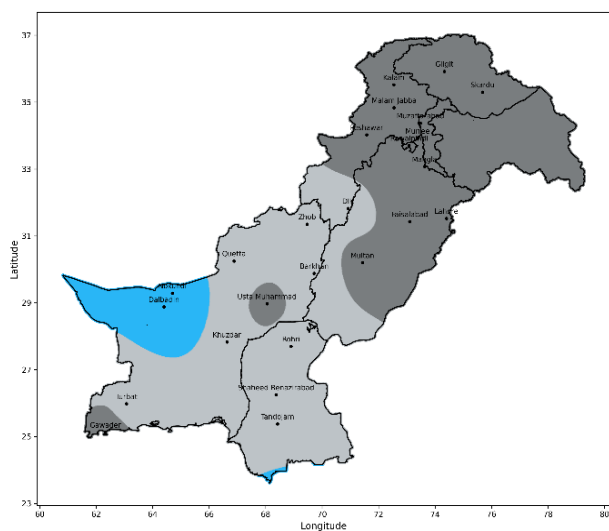
Mean Relative Humidity (%) during the Previous week (20th – 26th July 2026)

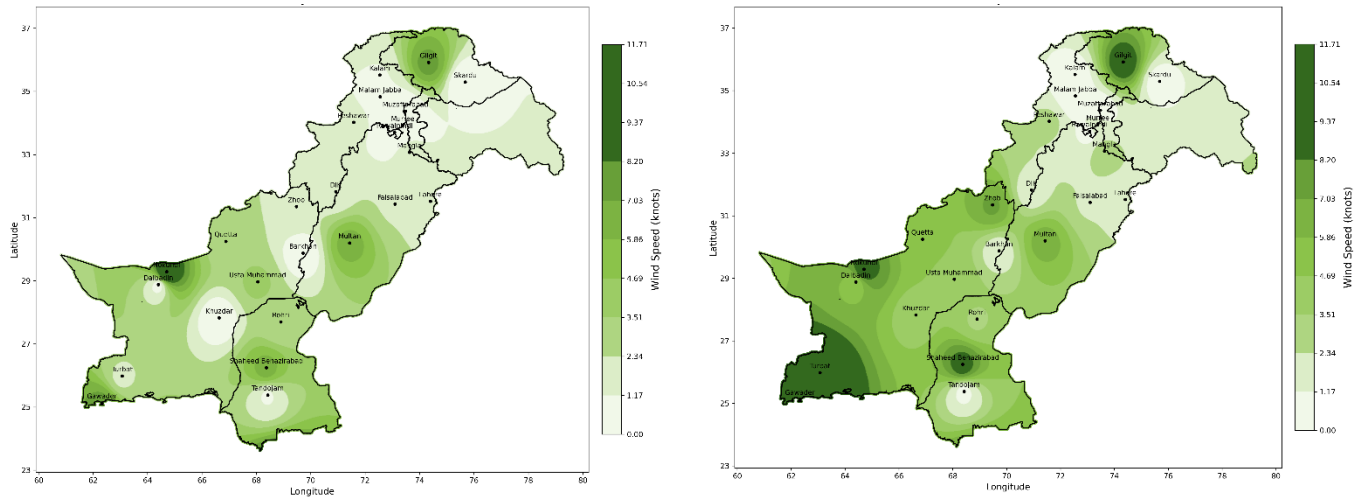


Total Growing Degree Days accumulated during the Previous week (20th – 26th July 2026)



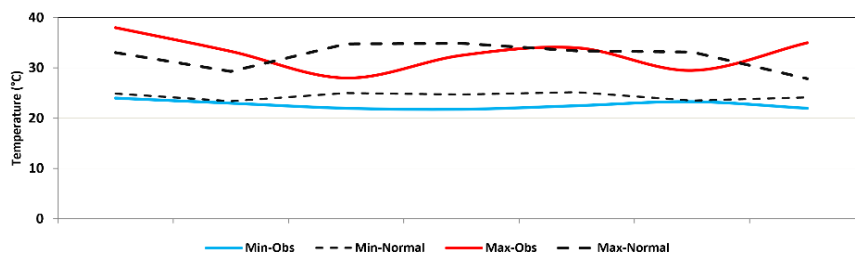
Mean Cloudiness at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (20th – 26th July 2026)



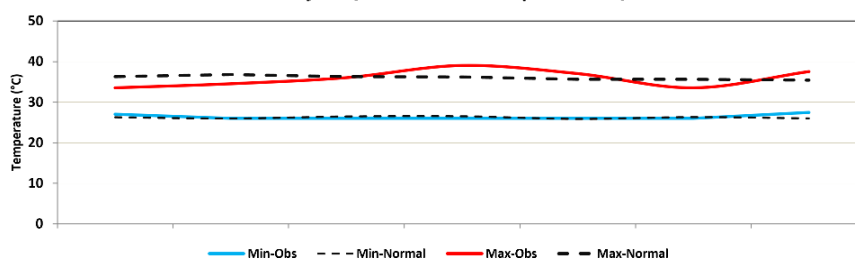
Mean Windspeed at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (20th – 26th July 2026)

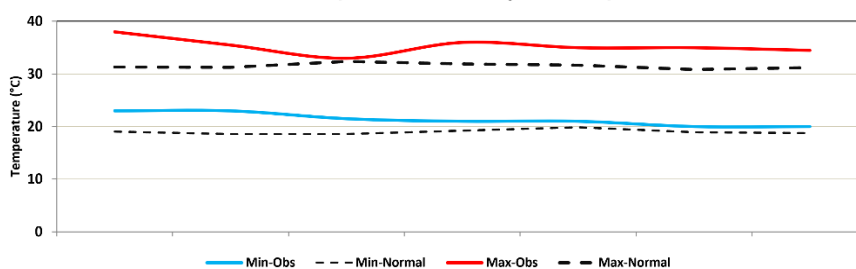

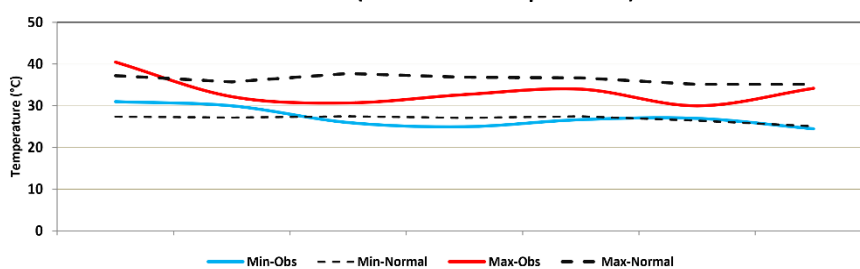
Tandojam (Min & Max Temperatures)



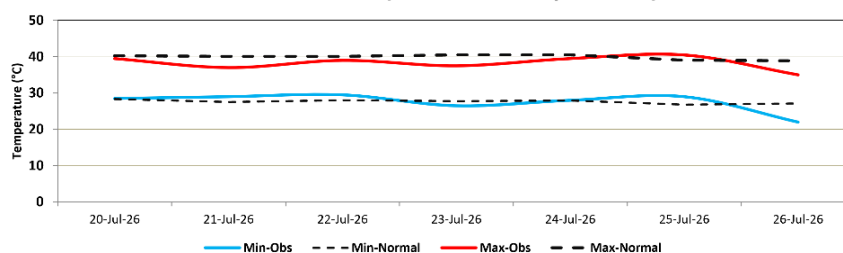
Quetta (Min & Max Temperatures)

Weekly Weather Forecast and Advisory for Farmers**(27th July –02nd August 2026)**

A Shallow westerly wave is present over upper parts of the country. A low-pressure area (LPA) located over west of Rajasthan has weakened.

MONDAY**27-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected over most parts of the country. Isolated rain-wind/thundershower may occur in Kashmir, northeastern Punjab, Pothohar region, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and southeastern Sindh.

TUESDAY**28-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected over most parts of the country. However, rain-wind/thundershower is expected at isolated places in Northeastern Punjab, Pothohar region, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir.

WEDNESDAY**29-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected in most parts of the country. Rain-wind/thundershowers is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, upper Punjab, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan.

THURSDAY**30-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected in most parts of the country. Rain-wind/thundershowers is expected in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, upper Punjab, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan.

FRIDAY**31-07-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected in most parts of the country. Rain-wind/thundershowers is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, upper Punjab, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan.

SATURDAY**01-08-2026**

Widespread rain-wind/thundershower is expected in Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Northeast Balochistan. Hot and humid weather is likely in southern parts.

SUNDAY**02-08-2026**

Widespread rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavy to very heavyfalls) is expected in Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Northeast Balochistan. Hot and humid weather is likely in southern parts.
