

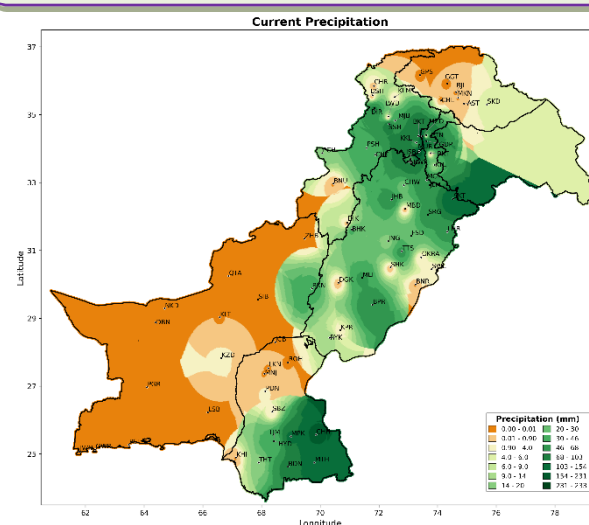
Weekly Weather and Crop Bulletin for Pakistan

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Rainfall Distribution (mm) during the Previous Week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)



Highlights of Past Weather (20th – 26th July 2026)

- Moderate to heavy rainfall was observed over Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab and southern Sindh. Whereas dry weather was reported from upper Sindh and Balochistan.
- Day time maximum temperatures remained above normal in most parts of the country except central parts of Punjab and Sindh where normal to slightly below normal temperatures were recorded.
- Daily minimum and mean temperatures were reported above normal over most parts of the country except upper Punjab where near normal temperatures were observed.

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Punjab

Heavy rainfall was observed from the scattered places of central Punjab while moderate rainfall was reported from rest of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 35.8°C & 26.8°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 126.8 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 76% and wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 2.5/2.3 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 188.00 mm at Muree during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.5°C at Bhakkar.

Crops: Peanut (Pothohar Region), Maize (Northeastern Punjab), Cotton (Central and Southern Punjab)

Balochistan

Dry weather was observed from most parts of the province whereas light rain was recorded at isolated location of northeastern Balochistan during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 38.3°C & 25.8°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 189.5 growing degree days were accumulated. The average relative humidity recorded was 38% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening was recorded 3.3/6.0 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 37.00 mm at Barkhan during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 48.5°C at Turbat.

Crop: Wheat

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Light to moderate rainfall was reported from the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 33.5°C & 22.5°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 126.8 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 75% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening

recorded as 0.7/1.6 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 96.40 mm from Saidu Sharif during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 41.5°C at D.I Khan .

Crops: Maize

Sindh

Moderate to heavy rainfall was observed from the southern parts of the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 38.3°C & 27.8°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 148.0 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 67%, and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 3.9/6.0 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 159.00 mm at Chhor during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 44.5°C at Dadu.

Crop: Cotton

Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir

Heavy rainfall was reported from Azad Jammu & Kashmir while light rainfall was recorded over an isolated location of Gilgit Baltistan during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 34.3°C & 20.2°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 122.0 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 65%, and mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/3.5 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 233.00 mm from Muzaffarabad during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 42.0°C at Chilas.

Crop: Wheat

Past Weather for Major Agricultural Plains
(27th July– 02nd August 2026)

Rawalpindi (Pothohar region)

Rainfall was reported as 97.00 mm from Rawalpindi during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.3/4.7 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity was observed as 76%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 34.4°C & for the recent

week, 130.2 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.5/0.8 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 37.3°C.

Faisalabad (Central Punjab)

Rainfall was reported as 27.20 from Faisalabad during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.2/3.7 Oktas during the week, average relative humidity was observed as 76%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.0°C & for the recent week, 140.1 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.5/1.7 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 38.5°C.

Tandojam (Lower Sindh)

Rainfall was reported as 20.00 mm from Tandojam during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.4/1.6 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity recorded as 77%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.0°C & for the recent week, 135.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.0/4.3 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 39.5°C.

Usta Muhammad (Eastern Baluchistan)

Rainfall was reported as 0.01 mm (Trace) from Usta Muhammad during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.2/4.0 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 64%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 40.2°C & for the recent week, 158.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Rice crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.2/4.5 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 41.5°C.

Quetta (Northern Baluchistan)

Dry weather was reported from Quetta during the week, however, cloudiness in the

morning/evening was recorded as 0.8/1.9 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 24%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.1°C & for the recent week, 165.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.9/3.8 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 37.0°C.

Past Weather for Sub-Regional Agricultural Plains (27th July– 02nd August 2026)

Multan

Rainfall was reported as 47.40 from Multan during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded 3.0/4.1 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity observed as 67%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.6°C & for the recent week, 155.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 5.7/4.9 Knots.

Lahore

Rainfall was reported as 48.20 mm from Lahore during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.4/6.0 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 74%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 35.0°C & for the recent week, 132.4 growing degree days were accumulated for Rice crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/1.4 Knots.

Zhob

Dry weather was reported from Zhob during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 0.7/2.3 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 43%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 37.2°C & for the recent week, 182.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.0/2.6Knots.

Murree

Rainfall was reported as 188.00 mm from Murree during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 6.1/7.7 Oktas during the week, while

average relative humidity observed as 88%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 22.7°C & for the recent week, 47.4 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.6/0.6 Knots.

D.I. Khan

Dry weather was reported from D.I Khan during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 4.0/1.0 Oktas. Average relative humidity was observed as 66%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.3°C & for the recent week, 164.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 2.0/2.0 Knots.

Peshawar

Rainfall was reported as 38.60 from Peshawar during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 4.0/3.3 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 77%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.6°C & for the recent week, 153.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.9/2.3 Knots.

Kalam

Rainfall was reported as 1.00 mm from Kalam during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.9/5.6 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 53%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 26.4°C & for the recent week, 80.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/0.6 Knots.

Gilgit

Dry weather was reported from Gilgit during the week; cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.1/3.7 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 54%. Mean day time temperature recorded as 36.7°C & for the recent week, 159.3 growing degree days were

accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/10.0 Knots.

Skardu

Rainfall was reported as 5.80 from Skardu during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.9/5.6 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 53%. The mean day time temperature recorded as 29.7°C & for the recent week, 122.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/0.6 Knots.

Crop Situation for Major Agricultural Plains (Based on data from Regional Agromet Centers)

Pothohar Region (Rawalpindi)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Rawalpindi.

Central Punjab (Faisalabad)

Cotton crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Faisalabad. Phonological Stage: Flowering completed.

Condition: *Very Good*.

Lower Sindh (Tandojam)

Cotton crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Tandojam. Phonological Stage: Flowering.

Condition: *Good*.

Northern Baluchistan (Quetta)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Quetta.

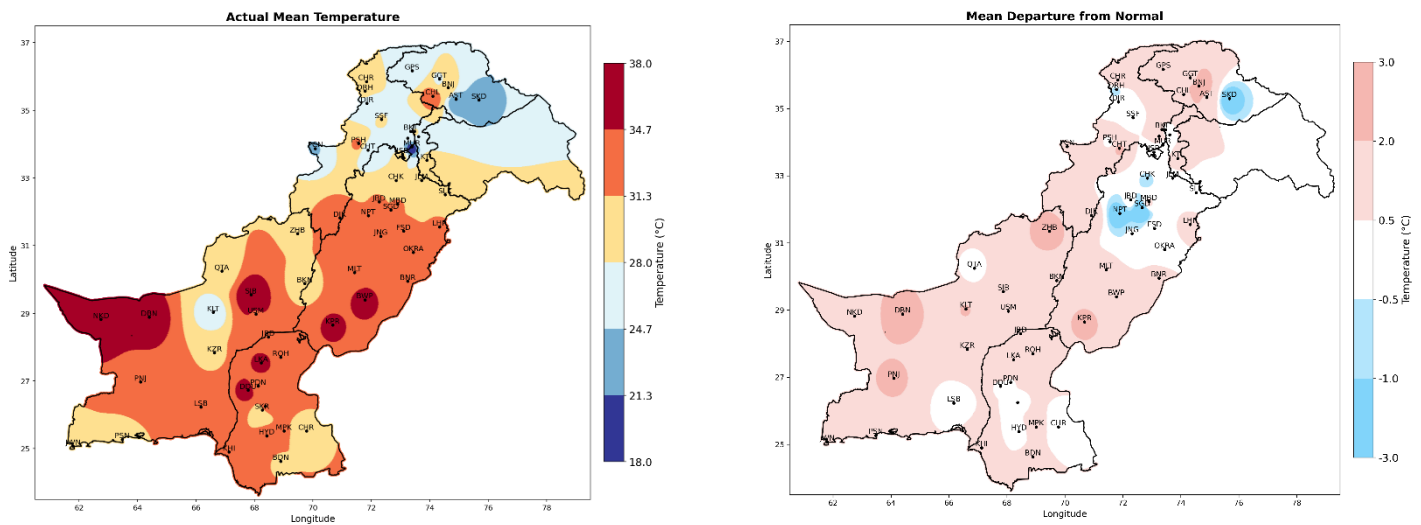
Eastern Baluchistan (Usta Muhammad)

Rice crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Usta Muhammad.

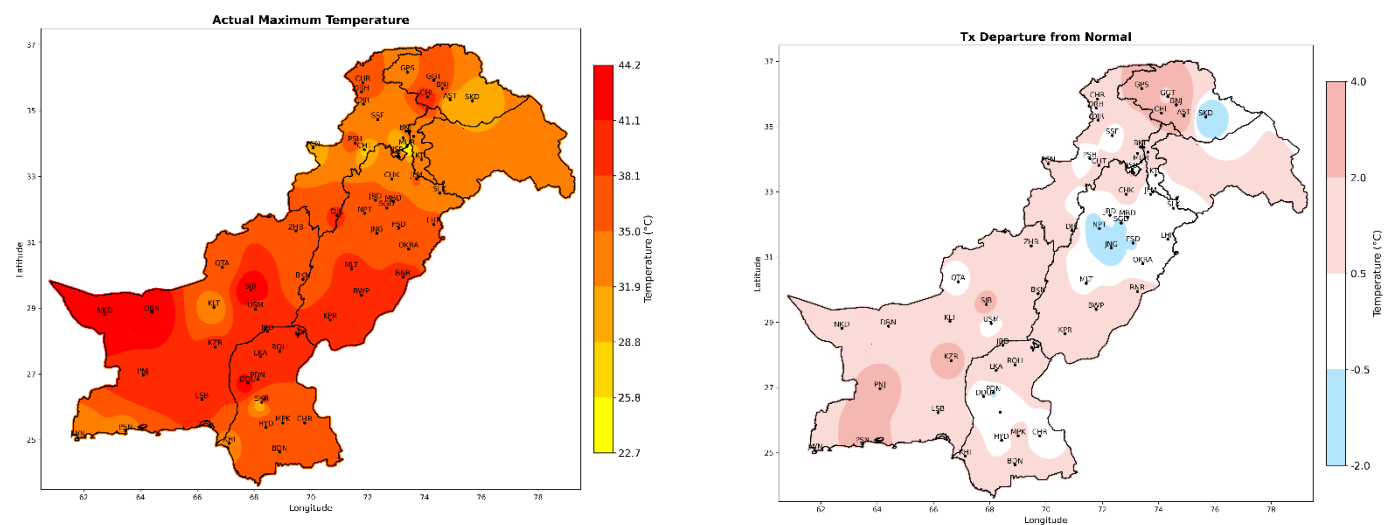
Phonological Stage: Third Leaf

Condition: *Good*.

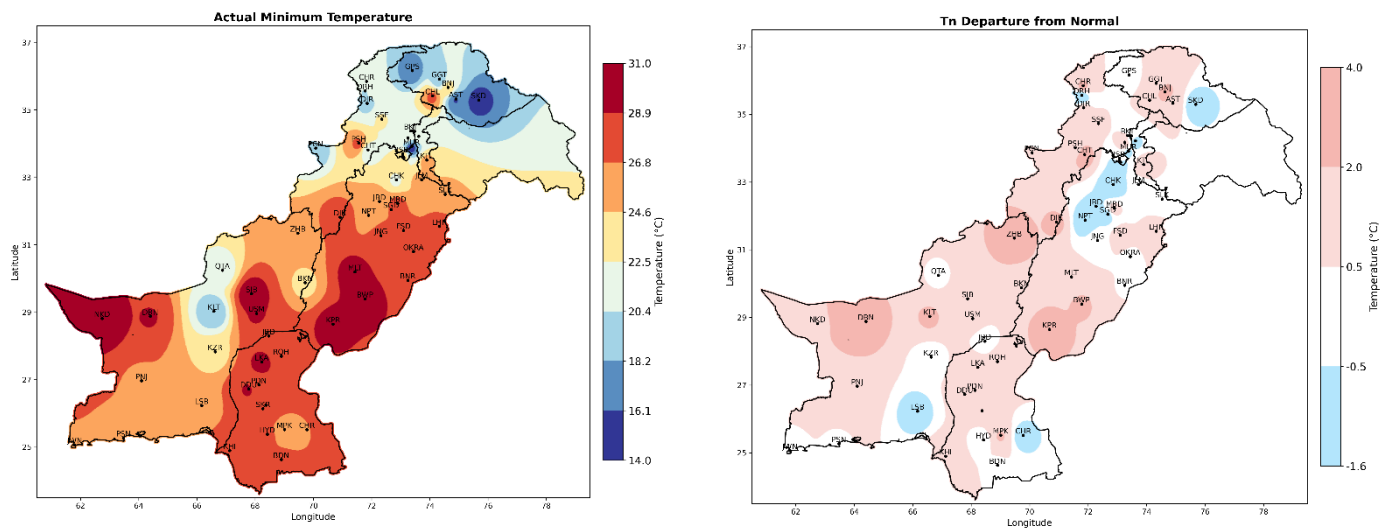
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)



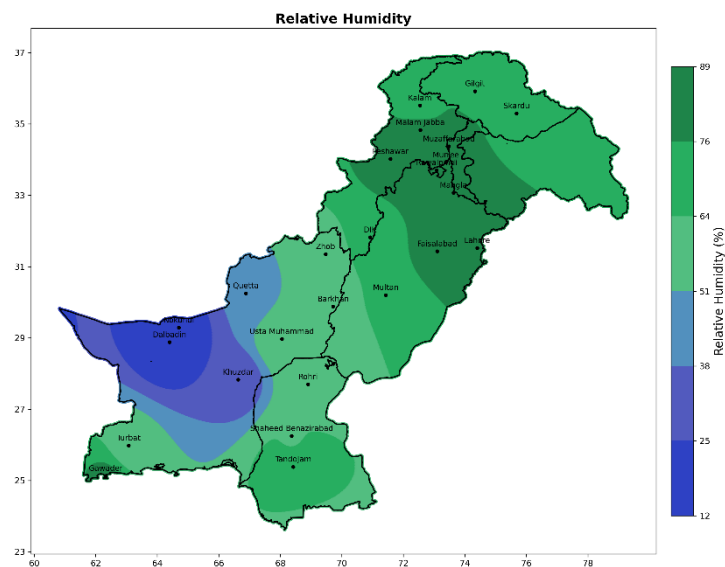
Actual & Departure of Max temperature (°C) for the Previous week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)



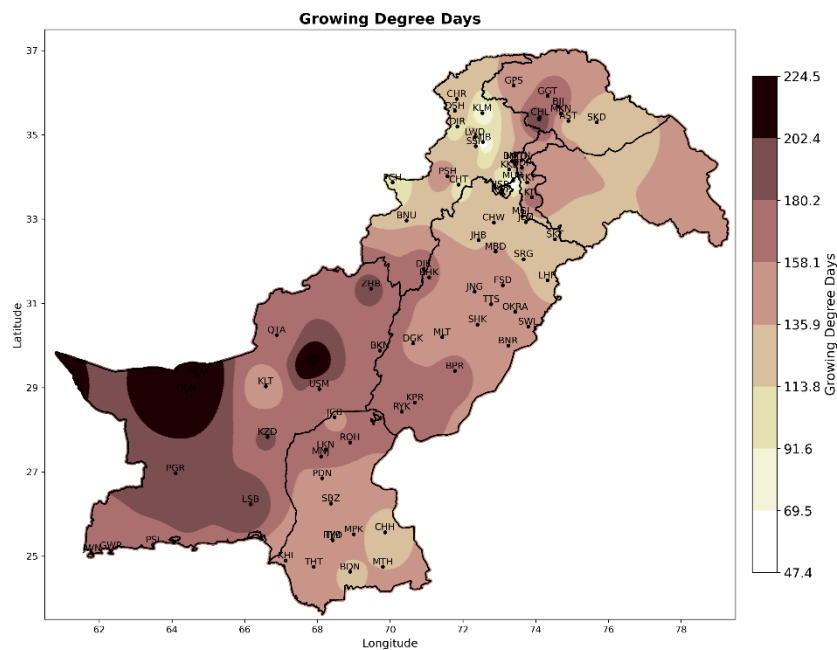
Actual & Departure of Minimum temperature ($^{\circ}\text{C}$) for the Previous week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)



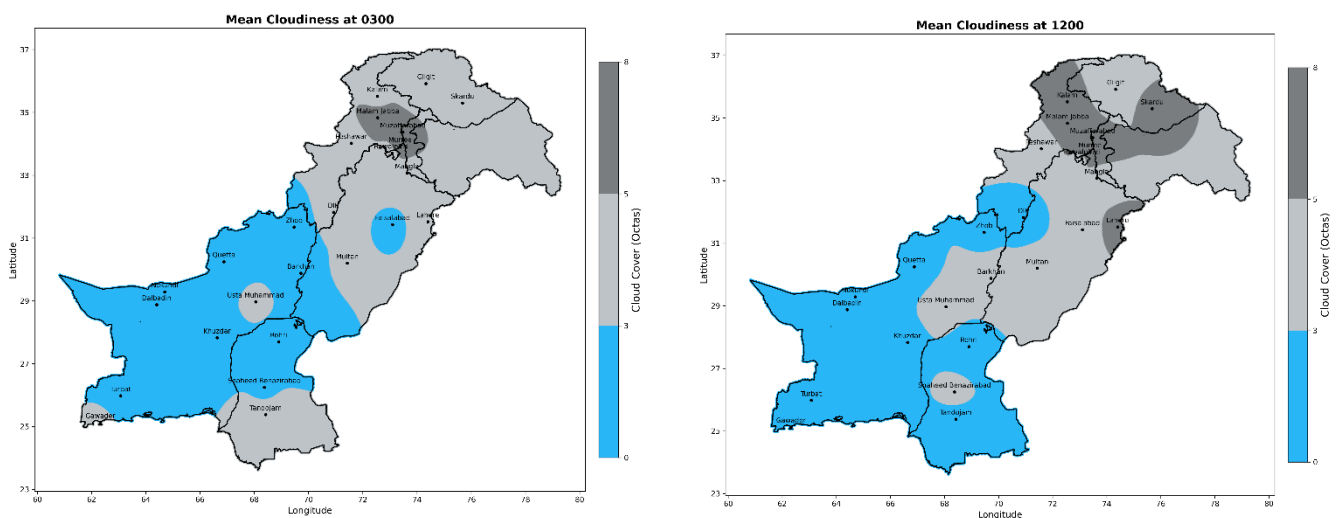
Mean Relative Humidity (%) during the Previous week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)

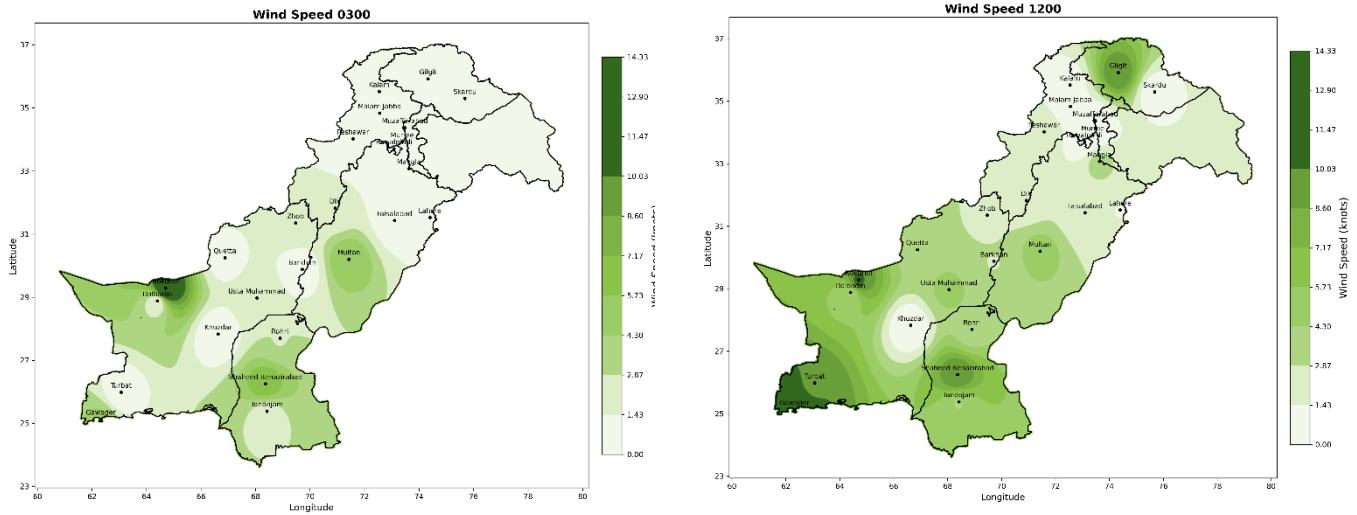


Total Growing Degree Days accumulated during the Previous week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)



Mean Cloudiness at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)

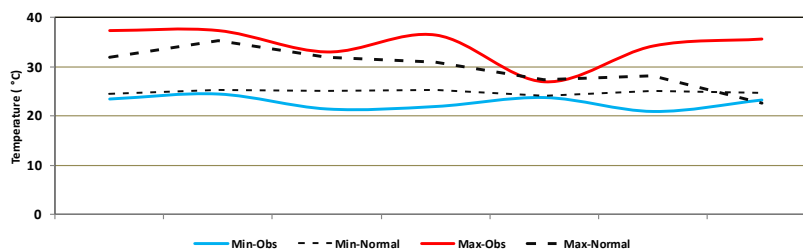


Mean Windspeed at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (27th July– 02nd August 2026)

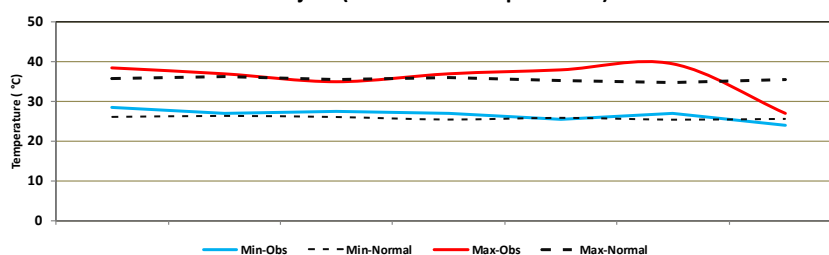
Comparison of temperatures for RAMCs (Minimum & Maximum with normal) during the previous week

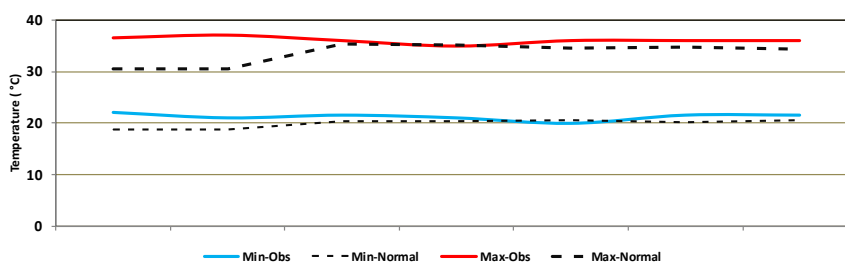
Rawalpindi (Min & Max Temperatures)



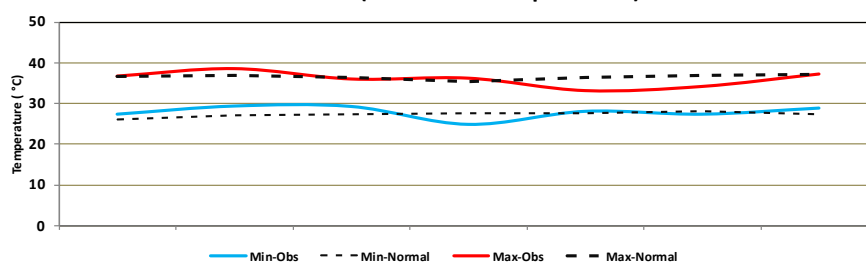
Tandojam (Min & Max Temperatures)



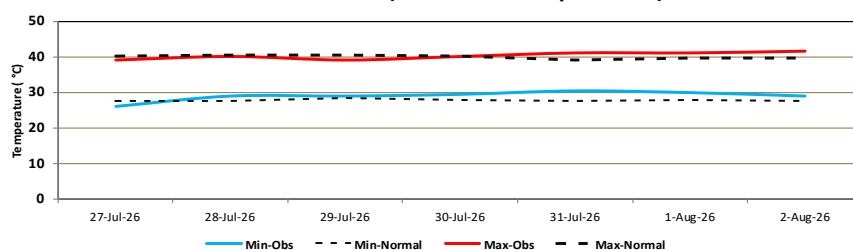
Quetta (Min & Max Temperatures)

Weekly Weather Forecast and Advisory for Farmers**(03rd – 09th August 2026)**

Monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in upper and central parts of Country. A westerly wave is also affecting upper parts of the Country and likely to persist during next 24hrs.

MONDAY**03-08-2026**

Widespread rain-wind/thundershowers (with scattered heavyfalls at times very heavy) is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Islamabad, upper/central Punjab and Gilgit-Baltistan, at scattered places in south Punjab, while at isolated places in upper Sindh.

TUESDAY**04-08-2026**

Widespread rain-wind/thundershowers (with scattered heavyfalls at times very heavy) is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Islamabad, upper/central Punjab and Gilgit-Baltistan, at scattered places in south Punjab.

WEDNESDAY**05-08-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected in most parts of the country. Isolated rain-wind/thundershower is expected in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pothohar region, Islamabad, northeast Punjab, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir.

THURSDAY**06-08-2026**

Scattered rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls) is expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Islamabad, upper Punjab, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir. Hot and humid weather is likely in other parts of the country.

FRIDAY**07-08-2026**

Scattered rain-wind/thundershowers expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Islamabad, upper Punjab, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir. Hot and humid weather is likely in other parts of the country.

SATURDAY**08-08-2026**

Rain-wind/thundershower is expected at scattered places in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, northeast Balochistan and south Punjab, while at isolated places in Islamabad, upper Punjab, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan. Isolated heavyfalls may also occur in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, northeast Balochistan and south Punjab during the period.

SUNDAY**09-08-2026**

Hot and humid weather is likely in most parts of the country. Rain-wind/thundershower is expected at isolated places in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Islamabad, upper Punjab, southeast Sindh, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan.
