

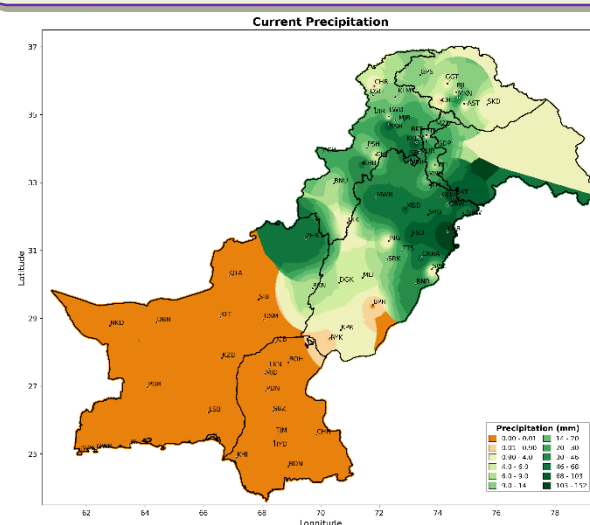
Weekly Weather and Crop Bulletin for Pakistan

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Rainfall Distribution (mm) during the Previous Week (03rd – 09th August 2026)



Punjab

Moderate to heavy rainfall was observed over upper Punjab particularly northeastern and central parts of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 35.5°C & 26.5°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 132.3 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 75% and wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 2.2/1.9 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 151.50 mm at Lahore (Airport) during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.5°C at Bhakkar and Noorpur Thal.

Crops: Peanut (Pothohar Region), Rice (Northeastern Punjab), Cotton (Central and Southern Punjab)

Balochistan

Isolated heavy rainfall was observed from northeastern parts of the province while dry weather prevailed over the rest of the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 35.1°C & 23.0°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 183.5 growing degree days were accumulated. The average relative humidity recorded was 40% and mean wind speed in the morning/evening was recorded 3.2/6.9 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 66.00 mm at Zhob during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 45.0°C at Sibbi.

Crop: Wheat

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Moderate to heavy rainfall was reported from most parts of the province during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 33.6°C & 25.8°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 116.5 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 75% and mean wind speed in the

morning/evening recorded as 0.6/2.0 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 113.00 mm from Kakul during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 39.5°C at D.I Khan.

Crop: Maize

Sindh

Dry weather was observed from the province during the last week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 34.4°C & 23.2°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 141.2 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity recorded as 65%, and mean wind speed in the morning/evening recorded as 4.1/4.7 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 43.5°C at Dadu.

Crop: Cotton

Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir

Light rainfall was reported from Gilgit Baltistan and light to moderate rainfall was reported from Azad Jammu & Kashmir during the previous week. Weekly mean maximum and minimum temperatures were recorded as 33.0°C & 21.4°C respectively. For the recent week, on average, 149.2 growing degree days were accumulated. Average relative humidity was recorded as 65%, and mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.4/0.8 Knots. The highest total rainfall was recorded as 34.10 mm from Muzafarabad during the last week. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 41.0°C at Chilas.

Crop: Wheat

Past Weather for Major Agricultural Plains
(03rd – 09th August 2026)

Rawalpindi (Pothohar region)

Rainfall was reported as 44.70 mm from Rawalpindi during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 5.0/10.0 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity was observed as 74%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 35.1°C & for the recent week, 133.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the

morning/evening as 0.0/0.1 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 39.0°C.

Faisalabad (Central Punjab)

Rainfall was reported as 82.20 from Faisalabad during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.6/4.0 Oktas during the week, average relative humidity was observed as 77%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 35.8°C & for the recent week, 134.7 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 14.1/2.3 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 38.0°C.

Tandojam (Lower Sindh)

Dry weather was reported from Tandojam during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 1.4/1.4 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity recorded as 75%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 34.9°C & for the recent week, 123.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.7/2.4 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 36.5°C.

Usta Muhammad (Eastern Baluchistan)

Dry weather was reported from Usta Muhammad during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 4.0/2.7 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 65%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 39.4°C & for the recent week, 151.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Rice crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.8/3.4 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 40.5°C.

Quetta (Northern Baluchistan)

Dry weather was reported from Quetta during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 1.4/2.0 Oktas during the week. On average, relative humidity was recorded as 25%. Mean day time temperature

was recorded as 34.9°C & for the recent week, 158.8 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.8/4.7 Knots. The highest maximum temperature was recorded as 36.5°C.

Past Weather for Sub-Regional Agricultural Plains (03rd – 09th August 2026)

Multan

Rainfall was reported as 5.20 mm from Multan during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded 4.1/3.6 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity observed as 67%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 37.3°C & for the recent week, 149.1 growing degree days were accumulated for Cotton crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 5.4/4.6 Knots.

Lahore

Rainfall was reported as 151.50 mm from Lahore during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 3.4/6.1 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 74%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 34.2°C & for the recent week, 127.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Rice crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.3/0.9Knots.

Zhob

Rainfall was reported as 66.00 mm from Zhob during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 1.1/2.0 Oktas during the week while average relative humidity was observed as 44%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 35.9°C & for the recent week, 174.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/2.9 Knots.

Murree

Rainfall was reported as 39.00 mm from Murree during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 6.3/7.1 Oktas during the week, while average relative humidity observed as 85%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 23.9°C & for the recent week, 53.3 growing degree days were

accumulated for Peanut crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.9/0.3 Knots.

D.I. Khan

Rainfall was reported as 2.00 mm from D.I Khan during the week, however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 3.0/1.1 Oktas. Average relative humidity was observed as 70%. Mean day time temperature was recorded as 38.1°C & for the recent week, 163.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.1/1.1 Knots.

Peshawar

Rainfall was reported as 10.20 mm from Peshawar during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening recorded as 3.7/3.3 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 77%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 36.4°C & for the recent week, 150.0 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 1.4/3.0 Knots.

Kalam

Rainfall was reported as 10.00 mm from Kalam during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 2.3/5.9 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 53%. The mean day time temperature was recorded as 26.5°C & for the recent week, 77.7 growing degree days were accumulated for Maize crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/1.4 Knots.

Gilgit

Rainfall was reported as 3.30 mm from Gilgit during the week; cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 5.0/5.9 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 63%. Mean day time temperature recorded as 32.5°C & for the recent week, 146.5 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.3/1.4 Knots.

Skardu

Rainfall was reported as 1.40 mm from Skardu during the week; however, cloudiness in the morning/evening was recorded as 6.4/5.9 Oktas while average relative humidity was observed as 53%. The mean day time temperature recorded as 29.1°C & for the recent week, 124.3 growing degree days were accumulated for Wheat crop. Mean wind speed recorded in the morning/evening as 0.0/1.4 Knots.

Crop Situation for Major Agricultural Plains (Based on data from Regional Agromet Centers)

Pothohar Region (Rawalpindi)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Rawalpindi.

Central Punjab (Faisalabad)

There is presently no crop grown in the fields of RAMC Quetta.

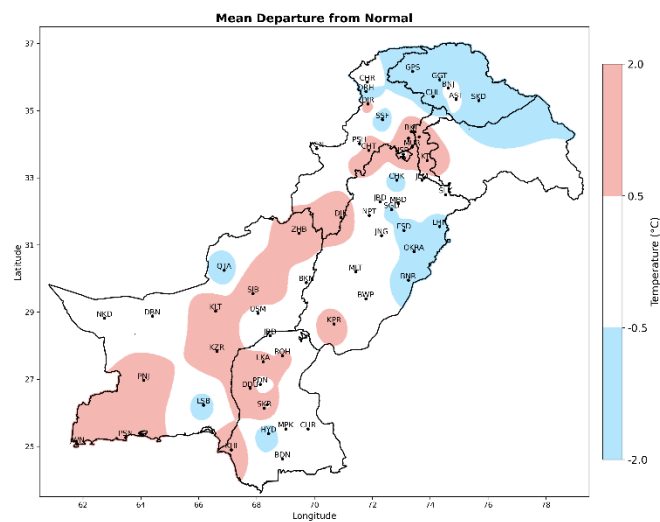
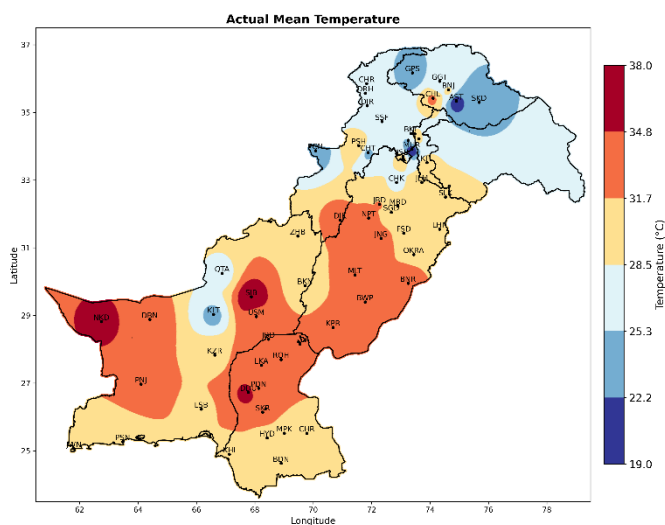
Eastern Baluchistan (Usta Muhammad)

Rice crop has been sown in the fields of RAMC Usta Muhammad.

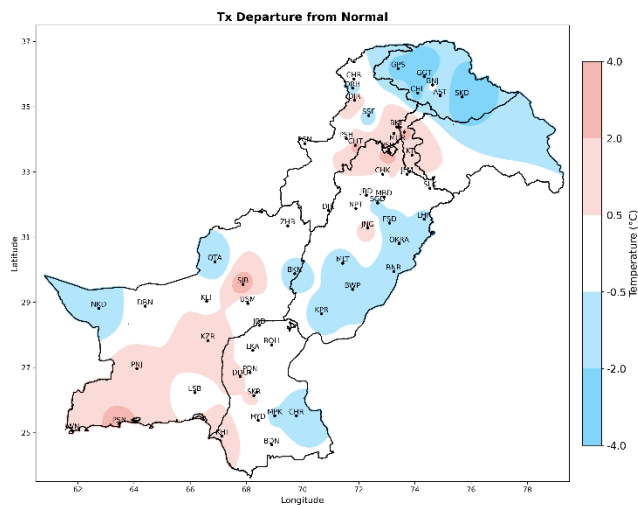
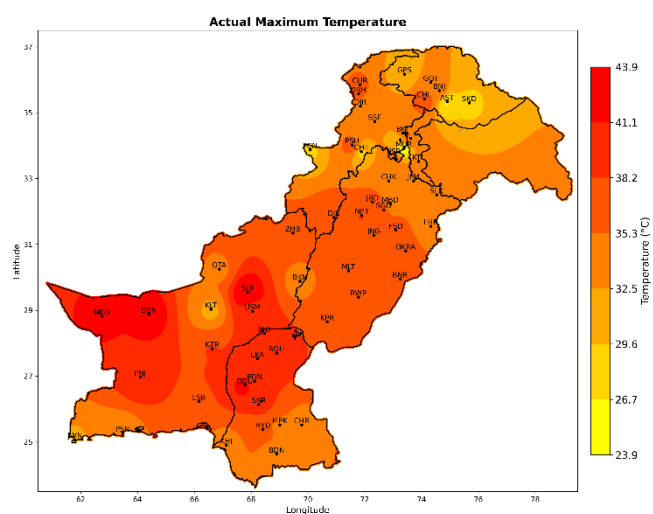

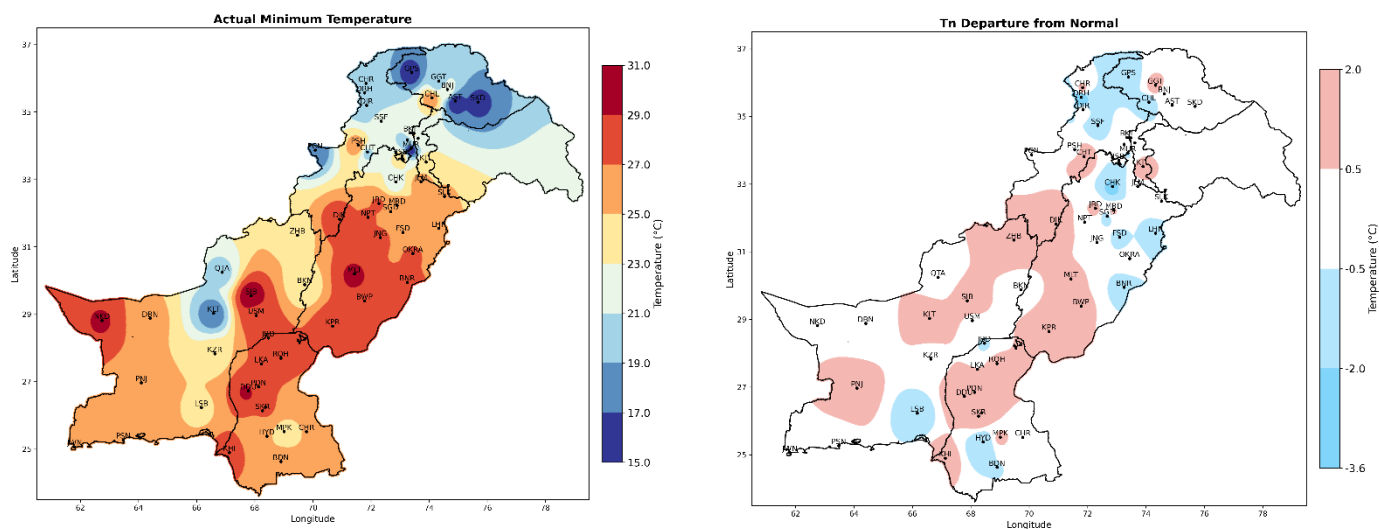
Actual & Departure of Mean temperature (°C) for the Previous week (03rd – 09th August 2026)



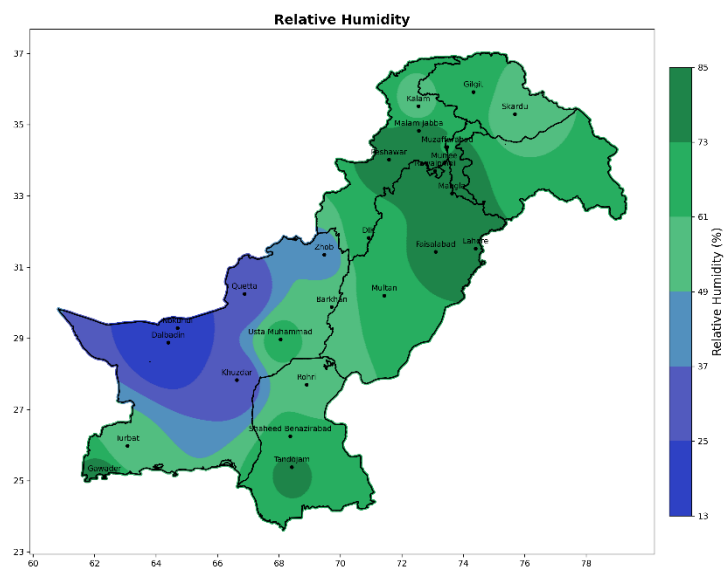
Actual & Departure of Max temperature (°C) for the Previous week (03rd – 09th August 2026)



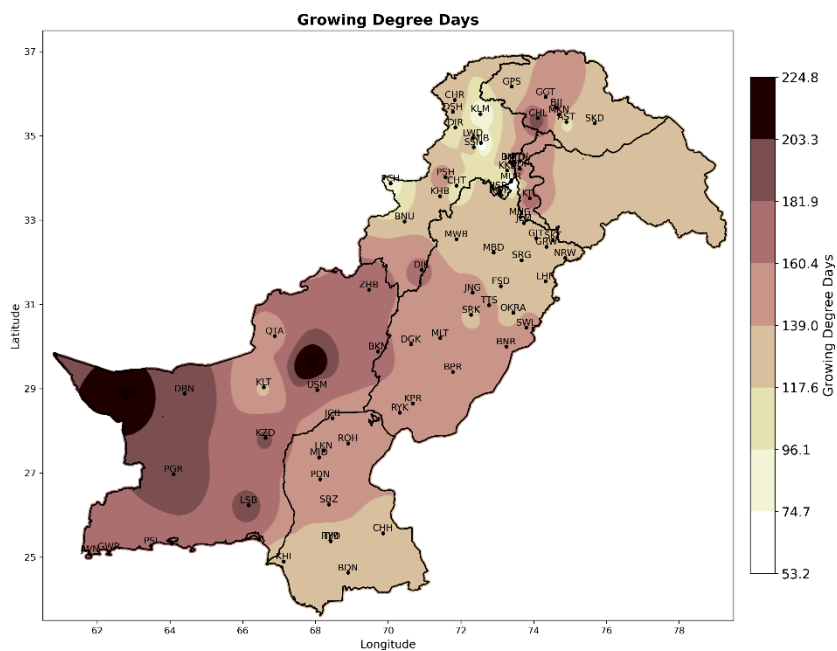
Actual & Departure of Minimum temperature ($^{\circ}\text{C}$) for the Previous week (03rd – 09th August 2026)



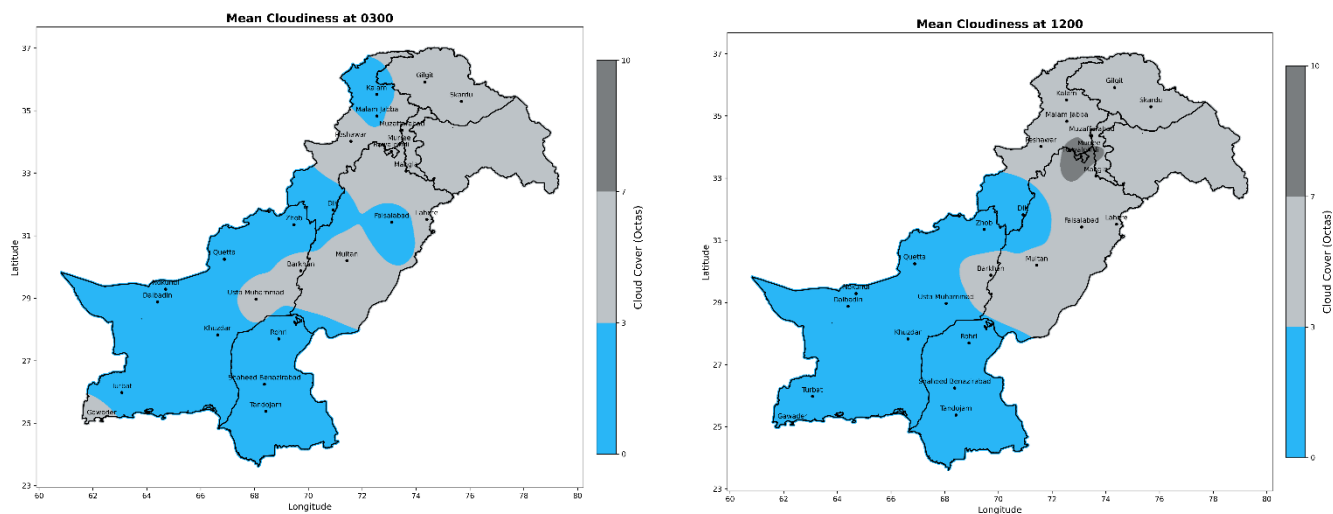
Mean Relative Humidity (%) during the Previous week (03rd – 09th August 2026)

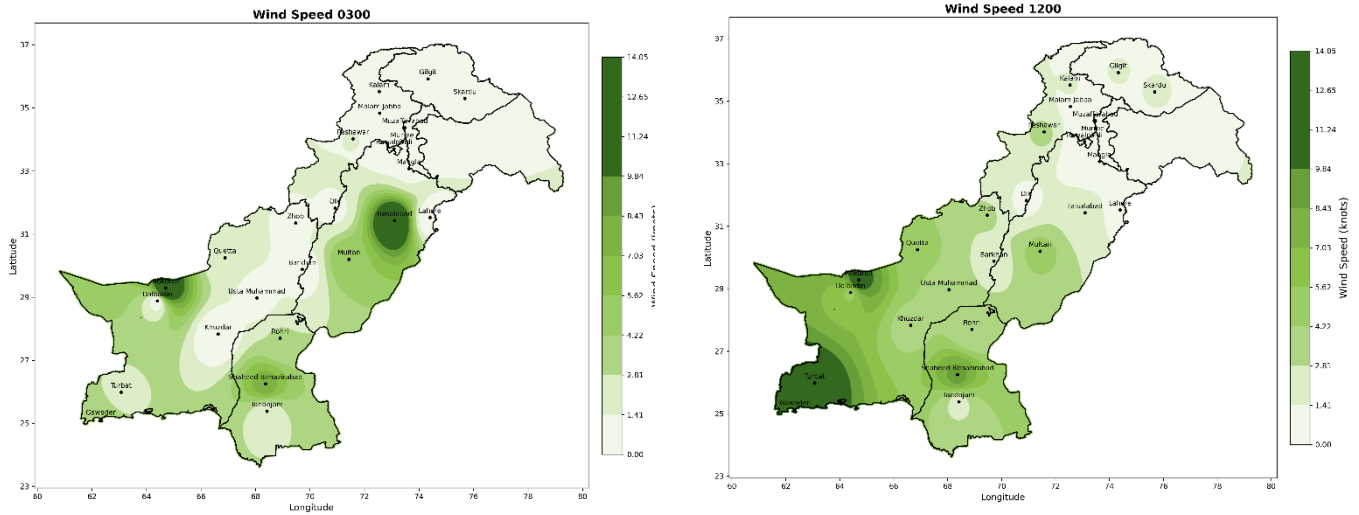


Total Growing Degree Days accumulated during the Previous week (03rd – 09th August 2026)



Mean Cloudiness at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (03rd – 09th August 2026)

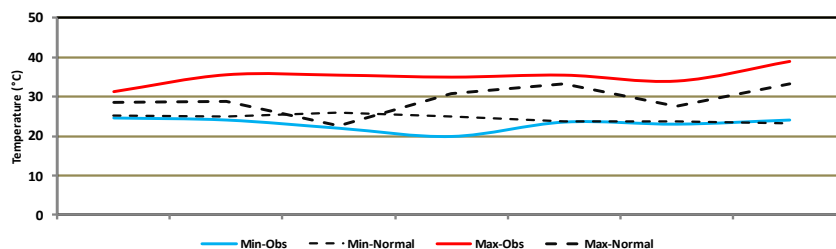


Mean Windspeed at 0800 PST and 1700 PST during the Previous week (03rd – 09th August 2026)

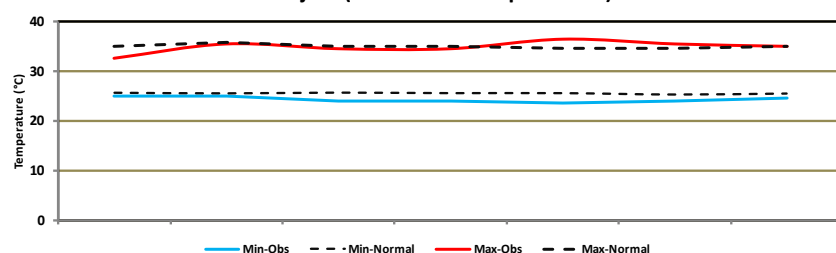
Comparison of temperatures for RAMCs (Minimum & Maximum with normal) during the previous week

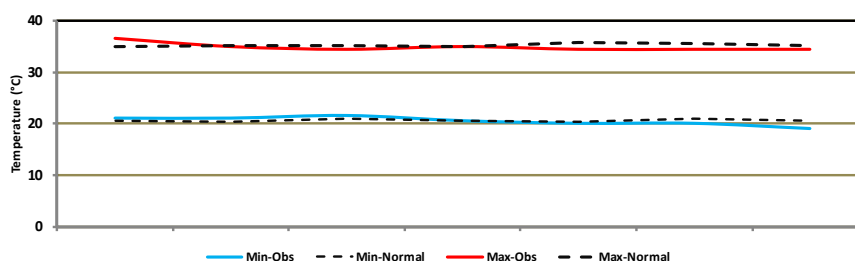
Rawalpindi (Min & Max Temperatures)



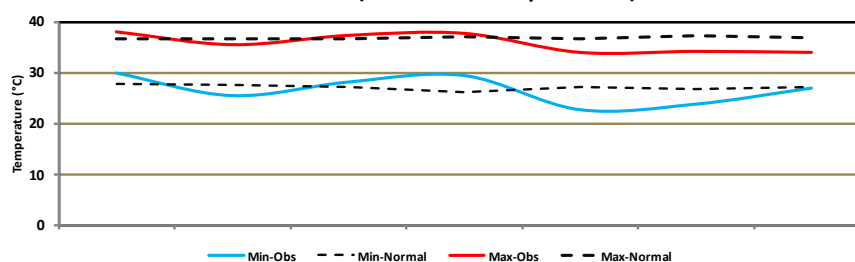
Tandojam (Min & Max Temperatures)



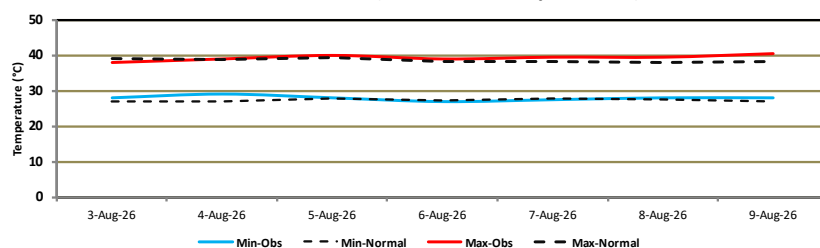
Quetta (Min & Max Temperatures)

Weekly Weather Forecast and Advisory for Farmers**(10th - 16th 2026)**

Seasonal low lies over northeast Balochistan. Weak monsoon currents are also penetrating in upper parts of country. A westerly wave is also likely to affect upper parts from tomorrow (Tuesday).

MONDAY**10-08-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected in most parts of the country. Isolated rain-wind/thundershower is likely in northeast Punjab, Kashmir and its adjoining hilly areas during night.

TUESDAY**11-08-2026**

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected in most parts of the country. Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls) is expected in Islamabad, Pothohar region, northeast Punjab, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit Baltistan and Kashmir.

SUNDAY**15-08-2026**

Isolated rain-wind/thundershower is expected in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, northeast Punjab, Pothohar region, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan. Hot and humid weather is expected in other parts of country.

ADVISORY FOR FARMERS

Farmers are advised to remove weeds from the standing crops and take necessary measures in order to protect their crops and orchards from the adverse impacts of heavy rainfall events. Due to the expected hot and humid weather in particular areas, cotton crop may be vulnerable to pest infestations and disease outbreaks. Farmers are advised to apply pesticides and sprays recommended by the Agriculture Department.
